# Price of Brent crude remains at its highest

The price of Brent crude oil continues to trade at its highest in 7 years, having risen by around 20% in the last year as a 10-billion-barrel surge in supply failed to offset a decline in supply from Russia. The oil supply remains tight due to US oil production remaining below pre-pandemic levels. And the Organisation of the Petroleum Exporting Countries and allies led by Russia, together known as OPEC+, are struggling to meet production targets.

Supply disruptions are mainly due to oil field outages and a flare ban in Europe with a number of barrels being sent to the West coast of Africa. Supply also remains tight due to US oil production remaining below pre-pandemic levels. And the Organisation of the Petroleum Exporting Countries and allies led by Russia, together known as OPEC+, are struggling to meet production targets.

At the same time demand for oil is picking up as the global economy is opening up from restrictive measures due to the coronavirus pandemic. But the higher oil prices are adding to inflationary pressures, which could lead to a speedy end to the economic recovery.
