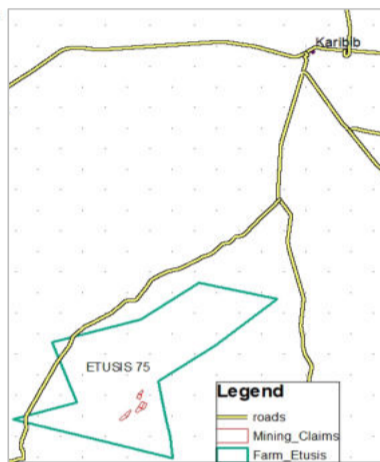

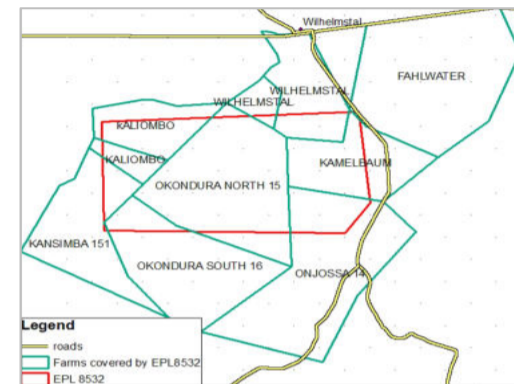
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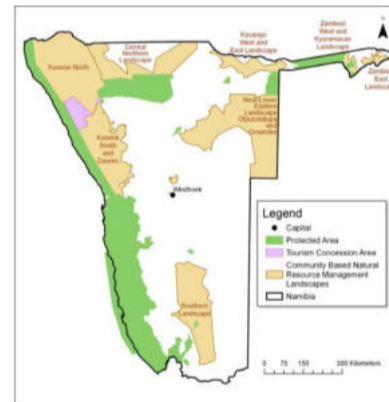

The Ministry of Environment, Forestry and Tourism (MEFT), in partnership with the Environmental Investment Fund of Namibia (EIF), hereby invites project proposals from eligible Community Based Organizations (CBOs) and Community Support Organizations (CSOs) to implement ecosystems-based adaptation interventions under the SAP006-EbA Project Small Grants Facility.



The SAP006-EbA Small Grants Facility is limited to community-based climate change adaptation actions located in 8 pre-identified landscapes that cover sections of **communal areas within thirteen (13) out of fourteen (14) political regions** of Namibia, as indicated in the map.

The potential projects must seek to implement adaptation concepts that address environmental problems of national concern caused by climate change and must be aligned to the landscape management strategies and investment plans of the target landscapes.

The grant facility has **two funding windows**:

- **Restoration and Climate Proofing** – this funding window will focus mainly on building community capacities in climate change resilience and improving adaptation planning as well as supporting concrete ecosystem management and conservation measures such as restoration of degraded rangelands, community gardening, tree plantations, restoration of riparian areas.
- **Eco-Enterprise Adaptation** – this funding window will focus mainly on grant support and training to community-level locally-owned small to medium enterprises, based on natural resources, as well as supporting the strengthening of value chains and market access for such natural resource-based products / services, which are identified as being commercially viable.

The following groups may apply for funding under this facility: Namibian dedicated institutions, organizations and agencies undertaking activities within these landscapes; community-level locally-owned small to medium enterprises; registered communal conservancies and community forests; community-based organizations; community-support organizations; Farmer's associations; basin water management committees; waterpoint committees; community cooperatives; and agencies implementing projects with communities, women groups and youth groups.

# Poles criticise FIFA 'first measures' over Russia



**F**IFA said on Sunday that Russia could continue to play matches albeit on neutral venues and only under the name 'Football Union of Russia' but warned the country could be excluded from competitions if the situation in Ukraine does not improve.

The announcements, which FIFA called "immediate first measures" were, however, swiftly criticised as insufficient by the head of the Polish Football Association.

Poland has said it will not play against Russia in their scheduled World Cup qualifying playoff on March 24 in protest at the invasion of neighbouring Ukraine.

FIFA, who condemned the "use of force by Russia in its invasion of Ukraine" said that no international soccer matches will be played in Russia and the country's flag and anthem will be banned from any of their matches abroad.

The global governing body said the national team would not compete as Russia but as the Football Union of Russia (RFU) and any 'home' games would be held with no fans on "neutral territory".

But Polish Football Association chief Cezary Kulesza criticised the FIFA stance and called for Russia to be expelled from the World Cup.

"Today's FIFA decision is totally unacceptable. We are not interested in participating in this game of appearances. Our stance remains intact: Polish National Team will not play with Russia, no matter what the name of the team is," he wrote on twitter.

"If FIFA's Human Rights Policy is more than just words on paper, now is the time to put it into effect, excluding the Russian Football Association from qualifying for the Qatar World Cup in 2022," he added in a statement.

The Czech Republic and Sweden, who are in the same play-off path as Russia and Poland, have also said they would not play against the Russians.

FIFA said it would try to find a solution with the three countries involved in the World Cup qualifiers.

"(FIFA) has already engaged in dialogue with all of these football associations. FIFA will remain in close contact to seek to find appropriate and acceptable solutions together," the statement said.

England's Football Association also said its national team would not play any matches against Russia "for the foreseeable future".

"Out of solidarity with the Ukraine and to wholeheartedly condemn the atrocities being committed by the Russian leadership, The FA can confirm that we won't play against Russia in any international fixtures for the foreseeable future. This includes any potential match at any level of senior, age group or para football," a spokesman said.

However, FIFA's statement did offer the prospect of further sanctions.

"FIFA will continue its ongoing dialogue with the IOC, UEFA and other sport organisations to determine any additional measures or sanctions, including a potential exclusion from competitions, that shall be applied in the near future should the situation not be improving rapidly," the statement said.

The International Olympic Committee urged international sports federations on Friday to either move or cancel events planned in Russia or Belarus. Russian troops entered Ukraine through Belarus when the invasion began on Thursday.

Ukrainian forces were holding off Russian troops advancing on the capital Kyiv, Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskiy said as the biggest assault on a European state since World War Two entered a fourth day.

Meanwhile, England's Football Association said on Sunday the England soccer team will not play any matches against Russia for the foreseeable future to "wholeheartedly condemn the atrocities being committed by the Russian leadership" after its invasion of Ukraine.

Other countries have also announced they will not play soccer matches against Russia.

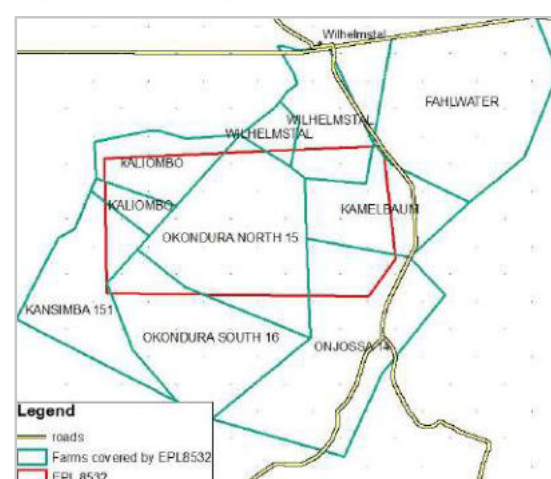

# Salah says Liverpool contract talks are not all about money

**L**iverpool forward Mohamed Salah said negotiations over a new contract at the Premier League club are not all about money, with the Egypt international's future at Anfield in doubt.

Salah's contract expires in June 2023 and negotiations over a new deal have been going on for a long time. British media reported this month that the 29-year-old is close to agreeing a deal with Liverpool to keep him until the end of his career.

"I don't know, I have one year left. I think the fans know what I want, but in the contract, it's not everything about the money at all,"

Salah told FourFourTwo magazine.

"So I don't know, I can't tell you exactly. I have one year left and the fans know what I want.

"This club means a lot to me – I've enjoyed my football here more than anywhere, I gave the club everything and everybody saw that... It's like a family here."

Salah, one of the world's most prolific forwards, has scored more than 150 goals for Liverpool since joining from AS Roma in 2017.

He said that regardless of the contract negotiations, he would stay at the club next season.

"I'm not worried, I don't let myself worry about something," he added.

"The season didn't finish yet, so let's finish it in the best possible way – that's the most important thing. Then in the last year, we're going to see what's going to happen."

Liverpool are second in the league on 76 points, one point behind leaders Manchester City, with six matches left.

The Merseyside club won the League Cup in February and have reached the FA Cup final and the Champions League semi-finals to remain on track for a haul of four trophies this season.

Concerns raised/contribution are as follows:

- Licence holder should be responsible for any damages
- there should be a trustworthy relationship between the licence holder and the farmer - to prevent theft - the farm owner should be involved in every aspect of the exploration process.
- Positive benefits are not permanent/not sustainable (Exploration jobs not permanent).
- Some employers do not pay their employees and they as a result resort to stealing farm equipments.
- Land access agreement should be mandatory
- Flying aeroplanes at low altitude disturbs game
- Audit environmental reports to be shared with farm owners
- there is apparently limited grazing land & gaming land on the farms - exploration will add to the strain
- Tourism & trophy hunting should have a separate subsection in the EIA report
- Exploration and mining would not be sustainable if processing does not take place in the mining areas.
- the presence of people on game farms will force the animals to move away
