## 2.4. PROJECT LOCATION




Figure 3: Locality map of the proposed AOI (Mining Claims) on EPL 8809 area in the Erongo Region, Namibia.

The location of the proposed EPL 8809 is situated in Western Namibia (**Figure 3**), within the Dorob National Park in the Erongo Region and approximately 23 km East of Cape Cross. To enhance potential impact mitigation, the proponent demarcated and marked a portion of the EPL into an area of 537 m² (herein referred to as Area of Interest (AOI)) which constitute Mining Claims 71556, 71557 and 71558.
