Prospecting Companies are welcome to attach any other information they like, such as copies of new agreements, letters of explanation, aerial photographs, or anything else of interest.
- 3. The map shall be used to indicate the following:
  - Areas where prospecting has taken place,
  - Roads or tracks made and/or used.
  - Houses and other infrastructure erected,
  - Excavations or other scars which have been rehabilitated,
  - Conflict areas, etc......
- 4. It is recommended (but not compulsory) that Prospecting Companies attach photographs to their report which visually illustrates the activities described in their report.
- 5. Failure to submit an Environmental Report shall constitute a breach of the Environmental Contract, which could result in steps taken against the Prospecting Company.
- 6. All information contained in the Environmental Report shall be treated as confidential.
- 7. The Prospecting Company shall ensure that all the information recorded in the Environmental Report is, to their best knowledge, accurate and correct.


