Murray withdraws from Djokovic clash in Madrid due to illness

Andy Murray has withdrawn from his last-16 match against world No.1 Novak Djokovic at the Madrid Open yesterday due to illness, tournament organisers said.

Three-time major winner Murray was set to face Djokovic for the 37th time in a highly anticipated clash on

day at the ATP Masters 1000 event in the Spanish capital.

"Unfortunately, Andy Murray is unable to take to the Manolo Santana Stadium due to illness," organisers wrote on Twitter.

"Instead, Andrey Rublev and Daniel Evans will open the day's play on centre court."

Former world No.1 Murray, who had earlier said he would skip the daycourt season in order to protect his fitness, accepted a late wildcard in Madrid and beat Dominic Thiem and Denis Shapovalov in his opening two matches.

Mohamed Salah has said Liverpool have a "score to settle" with Real Madrid after the Spanish side set up a repeat of their 2018 Champions League final by securing a comeback win against Manchester City.

Salah left the field in tears in the final four years ago after a heavy fall under a challenge by Sergio Ramos, with Real going on to clinch the title with a 3-1 victory. "We have a score to settle," Salah posted on social media after Real eliminated City 6-5 on aggregate.

Liverpool claimed their place in the final with a 5-2

aggregate win against Villarreal on Tuesday, with Salah saying that he was eager to face Real again. "I want to play Madrid," the forward told BT Sport. "We lost in the final against them, so I want to play against them and hopefully win it from them as well."

Liverpool, who trail City by a point in the Premier League, host Tottenham on Saturday. City play at home to Newcastle on Sunday and Pep Guardiola has said his players will need time to come to terms with their fate after Madrid's dramatic late recovery to knock them out.

"We need one or two days but we will rise, we will come up," City's manager said. "We will have to do so, with our people. We did everything we could. We were really, really close but in the end, we could not do it."

Asked whether this was his hardest European night as a coach, Guardiola replied: "I have had bad defeats in the Champions League before. [Such as] Barcelona against Chelsea when we played two exceptional games and couldn't make the final. But, yeah, it's tough. We can't deny it."

The Public Consultation Meeting was attended by four (4) people, including two Environmental Consultants from Excel Dynamic Solutions (Pty) Ltd (EDS). - **Please refer to the attached attendance register.**

INTRODUCTION AND WELCOMING REMARKS

Ms. Althea Brandt introduced the team of EDS and welcomed the attendees. The meeting attendance register was shared for attendees to sign for attendance, in order for them to be added to the list of interested and affected parties (I&APs), and receive further information on the ESA process.

MEETING AGENDA AND PRESENTATION

The agenda of the meeting included the following main points:

2.1 Brief Description of the Project

Ms. Brandt explained objective of the Environmental Impact Assessment and the public consultation meeting to the attendees (with reference to the Environmental Management Act (EMA) No. 7 of 2007 and its 2012 Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations on Public Consultation). The Environmental Consultant also presented the potential pre-identified potential positive & negative environmental and social impacts.

2.2 Public Open Discussion (Interactive Session)

Ms. Brandt provided the meeting attendees the opportunity to raise their concerns/issues and or comment on the proposed project activities. The issues and comments recorded are presented in **Table 1** below.

Comment/ issue No.	Issue / comment / question	Response and name of responder:
1.	<p>We do not have an issue with this type of development but only a problem with how these things are handled, especially with accessing our farms.</p> <p>Both my farm and my neighbors farm was accessed without consent.</p> <p>There are concerns regarding pollution, veld fires and theft that can arise when such activities take place on one's farm.</p>	<p>Ms. Brandt: I do understand where the frustration comes from and this is why we have meetings such as this one in order for us to explain the EIA process and get as much feedback from the affected parties.</p> <p>Normally we as consultants conduct the site visits and reporting and then apply for an ECC at MEFT and therefore we also try to keep as much communication between ourselves and the affected parties throughout all phases of the process. For this reason, I was not aware that the EPL holder had already made contact with you as the farm owner and visited the farms. It is important to have a good relationship between an EPL Proponent and the affected farmers.</p> <p>Within the EMP we will provide mitigation measures for the pre-identified negative impacts which is also a document that the EPL holder and workers should adhere to upon issuance of the ECC.</p>

FINAL REMARKS AND CONCLUSION OF THE MEETING

Ms. Brandt thanked the attendees for their input and for making the time to attend the meeting. She indicated to the attendees that their comments, have been noted down for consideration and addressing in the Environmental Scoping Assessment (ESA) Report as well as incorporating their recommendations into the draft EMP.

Furthermore, Ms. Brandt informed the attendees that the Environmental Assessment Report and Environmental Management Plan (EMP) will be shared with them for review and further comments. These documents will be made available through emails provided on the attendance register.

Once the review of the draft ESA Report and EMP is done, the documents will be finalized and submitted to the Environmental Commissioner at the Department of Environmental Affairs and Forestry (DEAF) for evaluation and consideration of an ECC.
