**EXEMPTION FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 11 AND 13 OF THE
ARCHITECTS' AND QUANTITY SURVEYORS ACT, 1979**

By the powers vested in me under section 23(1) of the Architects' and Quantity Surveyors' Act, 1979 (Act No. 13 of 1979), and after consultation with the Namibia Council for Architects and Quantity Surveyors, I exempt from the provisions of section 11 (requiring registration for architects and quantity surveyors) and section 13 (prohibition against practising as architect or quantity surveyors by unregistered persons) of that Act, any architect or quantity surveyor who is not ordinarily

resident in Namibia, and any architect or quantity surveyor (other than a natural person) which is not incorporated, established or formed in Namibia or which has its place of effective management outside Namibia on condition and to the extent that -

- (a) any such architect or quantity surveyor is performing work funded under the Millennium Challenge Compact between the Republic of Namibia and the United States of America;
- (b) the appointment of any such architect or quantity surveyor to perform such work is notified to the Namibia Council for Architects and Quantity Surveyors by the management of the Millennium Challenge Account - Namibia.

**EXEMPTION FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 11, 12, 13, 16 and 17
OF THE ENGINEERING PROFESSIONS ACT, 1986**

By the powers vested in me under section 28(1) of the Engineering Professions Act, 1986 (Act No. 18 of 1986), and after consultation with the Engineering Council of Namibia, I exempt from the provisions of -

- (a) section 11 (requiring registration for professional engineers) and section 16(1) (prohibition against practising as professional engineer by unregistered persons);
- (b) section 12 (requiring registration for incorporated engineers) and section 17(1) (prohibition against practising as an incorporated engineer by unregistered persons); and
- (c) section 13 (requiring registration for engineering technicians) and section 17(2) (prohibition against practising as an engineering technician by unregistered persons),

of that Act, any professional engineer, incorporated engineer or engineering technician, as the case maybe, who is not ordinarily resident in Namibia, on condition and to the extent that -

- (i) any such professional engineer, incorporated engineer or engineering technician is performing work funded under the Millennium Challenge Compact between the Republic of Namibia and the United States of America;
- (ii) the appointment of any such professional engineer, incorporated engineer or engineering technician to perform such work is notified to the Engineering Council of Namibia by the management of the Millennium Challenge Account - Namibia.

DEVIATION OF A PORTION OF TRUNK ROAD 6/1, PROCLAMATION OF A PORTION OF DISTRICT ROAD 1521, RECLASSIFICATION OF A PORTION OF TRUNK ROAD 6/1, PROCLAMATION OF A PORTION OF MAIN ROAD 81, PROCLAMATION OF A PORTION OF TRUNK ROAD 6/1, CLOSING OF A PORTION OF TRUNK ROAD 6/1 AND THE RENUMBERING OF A PORTION OF TRUNK ROAD 9/1: DISTRICT OF WINDHOEK

It is hereby made known that-

- (a) in terms of section 22(2) of the Roads Ordinance, 1972 (Ordinance 17 of 1972), that the Minister has, in the district of Windhoek-
- i) under section 22(1)(c) of the said Ordinance, deviate a portion of trunk road 6/1 described in paragraph (a) of Schedule I and shown on sketch-map P2221 by the symbols A-D from the route so described and shown, to the route described in paragraph (b) of Schedule I and VII and shown on the said sketch-map by the symbols E-F-G;
 - ii) under section 22(1)(a) of the said Ordinance, the portion of district road 1521 as described in Schedule II and shown on sketch-map P2221 by the symbols B-D be proclaimed;
 - iii) under section 22(1)(a) of the said Ordinance, the portion of main road 81 as described in Schedule III and shown on sketch-map P2221 by the symbols E-F be proclaimed;
 - iv) under section 22(1)(a) of the said Ordinance, the portion of trunk road 6/1 as described in Schedule IV and shown on sketch-map P2221 by the symbols G-H be proclaimed; and
 - v) under section 22(1)(c) of the said Ordinance, a portion of trunk road 6/1 as described in Schedule V and shown on sketch-map P2221 by the symbols E-H be closed.
- (b) in terms of section 23(3) the said Minister has:
- i) under section 23(1)(c) of the said Ordinance, the road described in paragraph a (ii) above, be declared a portion of district road 1521;
 - ii) under section 23(1)(b) of the said Ordinance, the road described in paragraph a(iii) above, be declared a portion of main road 81;
 - iii) under section 23(1)(a) of the said Ordinance, the road described in paragraph a(iv) above, be declared a portion of trunk road 6/1; and
 - iv) under section 23(1)(e) of the said Ordinance amended the classification of a portion of trunk 6/1 described in Schedule VI and shown on sketch-map P2221 by the symbols D-E to a portion of district road 1521;
- (c) It is hereby made known for general information that the number of the portion of trunk road 9/1 described in Schedule VIII and shown on sketch-map P2221 by the symbols C-F-G, has been changed to a portion of trunk road 6/1.

The said sketch-map shall at all times lie open to inspection at the office of the Roads Authority, Windhoek, during normal office hours.

**DECLARATION OF NAMIBIAN ISLANDS AS MARINE RESERVE:
MARINE RESOURCES ACT, 2000**

Under section 51 of the Marine Resources Act, 2000 (Act No. 27 of 2000), I declare the Namibian islands and the southern marine area described in the Schedule as a marine reserve for the protection and regeneration of marine resources.

SCHEDULE**DESCRIPTION OF GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES:
NAMIBIAN ISLANDS MARINE RESERVE**

The Namibian Islands Marine Reserve consists of all islands, rocks, islets, marine resources and marine area, and is described as follows -

- (a) the northern border is constituted by a line drawn from a point just north of Meob Bay at 24° 29' 10"S, 14° 30' 00"E, proceeding due east to the high water mark;
- (b) the southern border is constituted by a line drawn from the high water mark, proceeding due west to a point south-west of Chamais Bay at 27° 57' 34"S, 15° 28' 05"E;
- (c) the western border is constituted by a line connecting the list of co-ordinates provided in the Annexure;
- (d) the eastern border runs along the high water mark of Namibia's coastline, between Meob Bay and Chamais Bay.

Enforceable conditions are contained in the approved management zonations for the above-mentioned area.
