The work will entail two to three years of Prospecting and Exploration for Industrial minerals, base metals and rare earth metals within the boundaries of the EPL. The anticipated works include:

- Desktop study (Non-invasive technique): geological mapping, reviewing of existing geological maps and historical drilling data and / or exploration data for the area
- Field evaluation: fieldwork (lithological (soil/rock) mapping and sampling) will be conducted to verify desktop work. At this stage, there will be no physical soil/land disturbance yet.
- Feasibility Study / Detailed Exploration: drilling cores and trenching certain or target areas on the EPL.
- Rehabilitation of explored sites upon completion of exploration
