
5.2. Rural Development Projects: Recommended project were forwarded to Rural Service division.

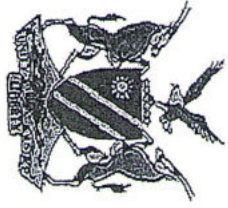

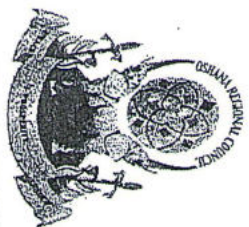

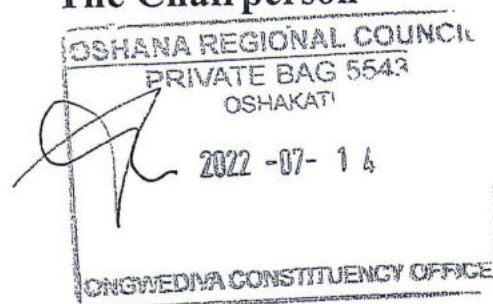
