INTRODUCTION

Glock Investments cc intends to develop a mine in Uis district, hence the need to conduct an Environmental Assessment on the area covered by EPL 8281 and the intended proposed exploration activities on the same EPL 8281 as per notice to applicant of preparedness to grant application for EPL 8281.

In this respect Junior Baiano Industrial Consultants (JBIC) cc have been appointed to carry out an Environmental Assessment study to obtain an environmental clearance certificate as per the requirements of the Ministry of Environment, Forestry and Tourism in terms of infrastructure development.

The study will incorporate biophysical, ecological and socio-economic baseline investigations relating to the proposed project.

In terms of the Namibian environmental Impact Assessment Regulations of 2012, an Environmental Clearance Certificate is to be obtained before the project can proceed.

This is because under the Government Notice 29 of 2008, Section:

3. Mining and Quarrying Activities

3.1 The construction of facilities for any process or activities which requires a license, right or other form of authorization, and the renewal of a license, right or other form of authorization, in terms of the Minerals (Prospecting and Mining Act), 1992.

3.2 Other forms of mining or extraction of any natural resources whether regulated by law or not.

3.3 Resource extraction, manipulation, conservation and related activities.

AIMS & OBJECTIVES OF THIS EIA PROCESS

The aims of this EIA:

- To comply with Namibia's Environmental Assessment Policy, Environmental Management Act (No. 7 of 2007) with its 2012 EIA Regulations and;
- Consult all interested and affected parties such as local residents, town council and regional council to ensure that their inputs are taken into account;
- To assess the significance of issues and concerns raised;
- Review the legal and policy framework and its relevance to this project;
- Describe general and socio-economic environment of the project to determine impacts and suitability to the project site.
- Identify and assess impacts related to the continued operations.
- Compile an Assessment Report and Management Plan (EMP) which includes recommendations and methods to minimize the identified negative environmental impacts of the proposed project.
- To identify existing environmental conditions and associated environmental sensitivities within and adjacent to the project area that may potentially be affected, i.e. Environmental sensitivity and monitoring procedures.

THE PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS

The Public Participation Process (PPP) is an integral part of the EIA process whereby it allows the public to obtain information about the proposed project, to view documentation, to provide input and voice any concerns concerning the project. The Public Participation Processes that will be undertaken will include consultation with the local authority, line ministries, government extension offices, owners of neighboring properties and other I&AP's living around the proposed area. During the meeting participants will be availed an opportunity to comment, ask questions and raise any concerns be it environmental or social regarding the proposed project. Comments will be recorded and considered in the Environmental Assessment report that will be submitted to the Ministry of Environment for review.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The proponent intends to establish a Lithium mine in Uis and provide employment to the local community and increase the availability of the multipurpose lithium by product and subsequently improve the economy of Namibia.

The proposed exploration activities will have minimal impacts on the natural resources, i.e. water, fauna and flora.

The operations will ensure compliance to land clearance requirements through obtaining a land clearance permit with MEFT.

Princess of Wales calls for better support for new mothers

Catherine, Princess of Wales has called for better support for new mothers.

The 40-year-old royal - who has children Princes George, nine, and Louis, four, and seven-year-old Princess Charlotte with husband Prince William - called for maternity and children's services to "join the dots" and offer more "holistic" support as she expressed her hopes for integrated children's centres being opened throughout the UK.

The facilities gather midwives, health visitors, social workers, psychiatrists and relevant charities under one roof to provide help and support to vulnerable mothers during their children's early years.

Speaking as she visited Colham Manor Children's Centre in Hillingdon, London, on Wednesday, Catherine said: "I think more places like this would be so valuable in communities, bringing people together.

"It's fantastic what's being done here. It's not about having more services, it's actually about being able to integrate them."

Catherine was wearing a poppy in honour of Remembrance Day but handed it over to three-year-old Akeem after he pointed it out on her coat.

She told the toddler the symbol was "remembering all the soldiers who died in the war".

The princess praised the staff at the centre, which helps women from pregnancy onwards, as she joined one of their meetings.

She said: "It is amazing what you've achieved.

"I was chatting to mums, lots of different life experiences, different experiences of engaging with their community here, but also the community services in general. lol

SCHEDULE OF SUPPLEMENTARY TERMS AND CONDITIONS TO BE IMPOSED ON THE GRANT OF AN EXCLUSIVE PROSPECTING LICENCE No. 8281 IN FAVOUR OF GLOCK INVESTMENTS CC.

PART 1 - GENERAL

1. The exclusive prospecting licence shall endure for a period of three (3) years reckoned from the date of issue of the Environmental Clearance Certificate unless it is abandoned in terms of Section 54 of the Minerals (Prospecting and Mining) Act, 1992, (hereinafter "the Act") or cancelled in terms of Section 55 of the Act or on application made to the Minister in terms of section 72 of the Act, it is renewed by the Minister for any further period or periods.
2. 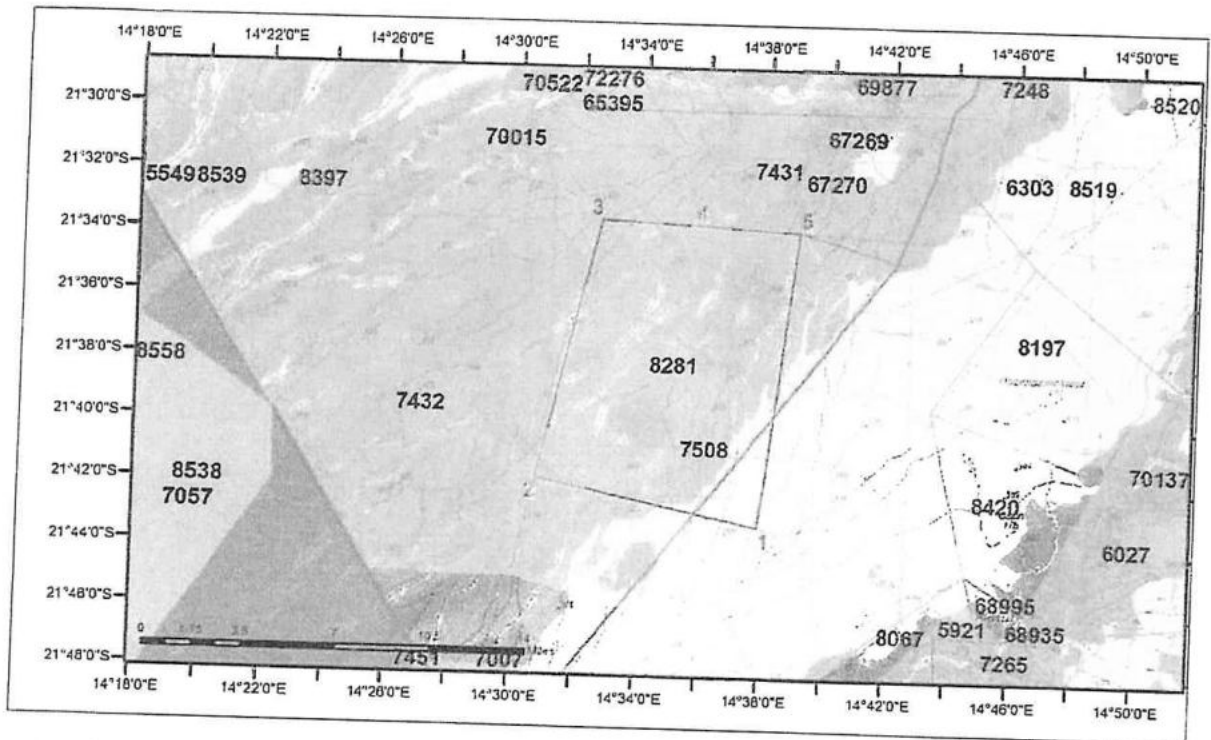

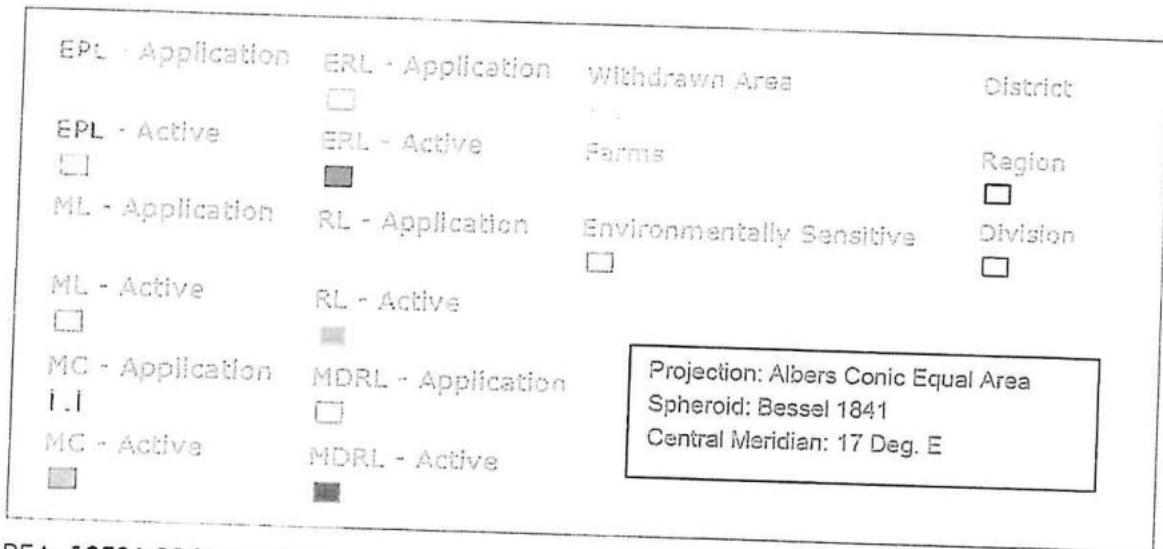


DIAGRAM – EXCLUSIVE PROSPECTING LICENCE – 8281
