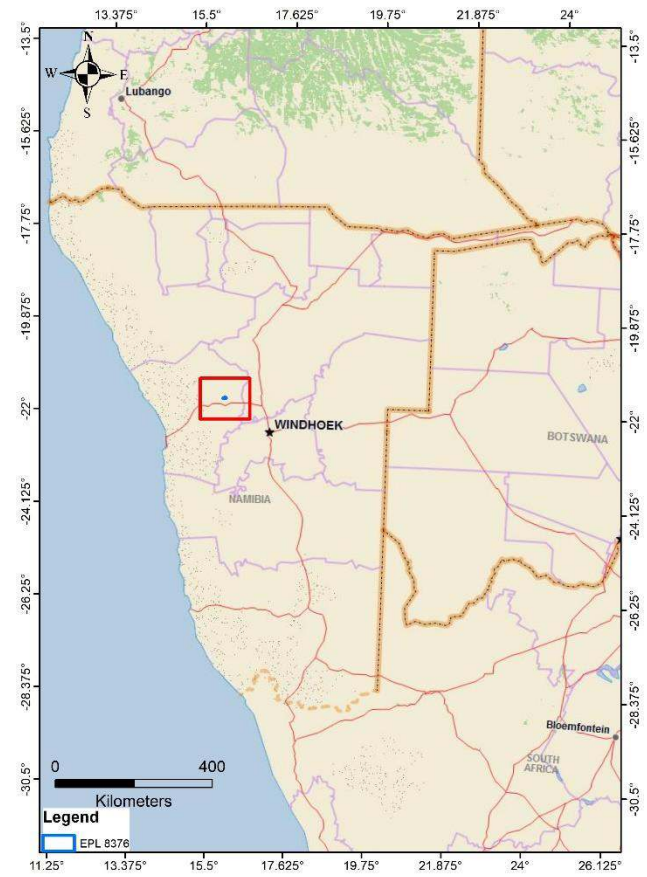

# Pope Francis urges priests and nuns to delete porn from their phones

**Pope Francis warned priests and nuns against watching pornography online and urged them to delete it from their phones to avoid falling into temptation.**

The 85-year-old pontiff told a Vatican session that porn on the internet was “a vice that so many people have... even priests and nuns,” in response to questions about using digital and social media responsibly.

“The devil enters from there... It weakens the priestly heart,” he told seminarians and priests studying in Rome this week, in remarks published by the Vatican on Wednesday.

“Dear brothers, pay attention to this,” he said. “And if you can delete this from your mobile phone, delete it, so you won’t have the temptation in hand.”

The head of the Roman Catholic Church recounted that he had once received a cellphone when he became a bishop, which

he used to make a single call to his sister and immediately returned.

“It is not my world, but you must use it,” Francis said in comments about the benefits and risks of the internet. He asked his listeners to excuse him for mentioning porn, but described it as “a reality”.

“I will not say raise your hand if you have had at least one experience of this,” he added, asking them to reflect on it personally.

During his pontificate, Francis’s more outspoken – and at times less conservative – overtones than his predecessors, including his invitation of LGBT advocates to the Vatican, have drawn global attention and pushback from within the church.

In his nine-year tenure, he has issued apologies at several points, notably for sexual abuse in the Catholic Church.

Among them was a 2018 letter to Chilean bishops, in which he

apologised for what he described as his own errors in handling a sex-abuse scandal.

That year, the church was shaken by accusations that Francis knew and covered up the alleged sexual misconduct of an American cardinal, The Washington Post reported.

In 2020, the Vatican said it would look into how the pope’s official Instagram account appeared to have liked a Brazilian model’s photo, in an incident that she quipped would help get her into heaven. The pope’s Instagram account, managed by a team under the username franciscus, has 8.9 million followers.

While he has been healthy during much of his papacy, recent medical issues have raised questions about whether Francis could retire, and he has acknowledged that he could have to slow down his globe-trotting pace. In December, he will become the oldest sitting pope since the 1800s.

# Bad parenting styles to avoid, unless you want to raise an avoidant adult

**A**lthough discipline is crucial, parents should use it with caution.

Children's behaviour is erratic, just like ours. Your child may make mistakes occasionally that you wouldn't have predicted and, at other times, they may go too far, leaving you helpless in the circumstance.

In these circumstances, harsh discipline is the natural response. Parents may act violently or say things that could lower their child's self-esteem.

Such parenting techniques can cause youngsters to exhibit avoidant behaviour, in which they effectively do not think about changing their behaviour.

You should consider why you are reprimanding or punishing your child as a parent. What kind of behaviour do you want your child to exhibit?

Once the youngster realises what is wrong with their behaviour, they can quickly change it and use different techniques or behaviours.

Three main parenting approaches that can make your child avoidant and obstinate,

willing to do whatever to avoid getting caught rather than owning up to their error and changing their behaviour:

### Corporal punishment

According to research, physical punishment of any form is bad for your child's health. It wouldn't help to significantly alter a child's behaviour, but it might noticeably alter the child's structure.

In addition to the variables, physical punishment encourages the same behaviour in the child and increases the likelihood that the youngster will beat other children in the future.

Your child will avoid you if you employ physical punishment because they know what happens next: a beating. Lying, maintaining secrecy and engaging in covert behaviour will make a youngster anxious and encourage them to engage in more avoidant behaviour.

Talking the child through their feelings and offering advice on how to better control their emotions might help them change inappropriate or out-of-character behaviour.

Inconsistency isn't the answer. Consistency is key to discipline, and if it's lacking, no amount of punishment will work. Never give your child the impression that they are free to act however they choose all the time and that they can be screamed at at random moments.

Confusion may result from his, and the child's behaviour may then show signs of worry. Make sure you explain your expectations to your child after a negative experience and wrap things up positively, so that your youngster feels understood and satisfied.

### Avoid taking too much away

Because these settings typically see a meeting of the complete peer group, preventing your child from attending significant or special occasions like a birthday party or a society function can be harmful to their mental health.

The child can grow to hate you as a result. On your list of things you don't take away from people, you should also include stress toys, colouring books and other comforting goods.-IOL
