

"Yes, I have been exonerated but the nightmare I have gone through can never be erased." Mahachi also broke down the

incident about his son's medical trauma and how he took the fall for his family's negligence.

"It was only when his septic ulcers exploded that he was rushed to hospital. Once examined, the medical export decided that the condition was spreading so fast his leg would have to be amputated," he explained.


