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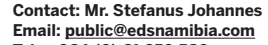

The public consultation meeting was attended by nine (9) people, including: An Economic Consultant, a GIS technician, an Archaeologist; all from Excel Dynamic Solutions (Pty) Ltd (EDS), and farmers affected by the EPL.

1. INTRODUCTION AND WELCOMING REMARKS

Mr. Stefanus Johannes (a GIS technician) officially opened the meeting with welcoming remarks. Mr. Stefanus Johannes (a GIS technician / Consultant) introduced himself and his colleagues.
