

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

The Consultation Meeting was attended by twenty-four (24) people as provided in the attendance register **attached hereto**. Some of the attendees opted not to sign the attendance register, and their choice was respected by the Environmental Consultant.

INTRODUCTION AND WELCOMING REMARKS

The meeting was officially opened by Ms. Fredrika Shagama (Environmental Consultant) and welcomed everyone to the meeting. The Secretary for the Gaio-Daman Traditional Authority, Mr. Manfred Katjoko provided translations from English to Nama-Damara Language and vice-versa throughout the meeting.

The meeting attendance register was circulated for the attendees to write down their names, contact details to be added to the list of I&APs and receive further information on the EIA process. The copies of the Background Information Document (BID) were circulated to the attendees for self-reading and ask questions after the presentation by the Environmental Consultant.

MEETING AGENDA AND PRESENTATION

The agenda of the meeting included the following main points:

- Explanation of what an ESA is, its Process and the Public Role in the Process: The purpose of the meeting was given to the attendees with reference to the Environmental Management Act (EMA) No. 7 of 2007 and its 2012 Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations on Public Consultation. Ms. Shagama further explained what an ESA is and that the proposed exploration activities are one of the listed activities in the 2012 EIA Regulations of the EMA that cannot be undertaken without an Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC) from the Environmental Commissioner. Se further clarified that the Proponent (Codebreak Investments) has not been granted the rights to explore in the area yet, pending an ECC. Therefore, the Ministry of Mines and Energy (MME) has only gave the Proponent a provisional grant (intention to grant the EPL).
- Brief Description of the Project: Ms. Shagama informed and showed meeting attendees the areas covered by the EPL, i.e., *#*Khoadi-//Hôas Conservancy, which covers communal farms such as Farm Condor No. 617, Farm Emmanuel No. 613, Farm No. 612, Farm Deo Volento No. 610, and Farm Atlanta No. 618. It was found that Farm Bruno 614 and Ombonde 616 are commercial farms (to be consulted). She further presented a summary of the proposed prospecting and exploration methods to give the attendees an idea of what the project will entail. She also indicated that the Proponent applied to be granted for the rights to prospect & explore for Base & Rare Metals, Dimension Stone, Industrial Minerals, and Precious Metals.
- Presentation of Potential Project Impacts: The Environmental Consultant (Ms. Shagama) also presented the potential pre-identified potential positive & negative environmental and social impacts associated with the proposed project activities.
- Public Open Discussion (Interactive Session): The meeting attendees were provided an opportunity to raise their concerns/issues and or comments for consideration in the Environmental Assessment Repot and its Environmental Management Plan. The issues and comments recorded are presented in Table 1 below.

2ND PUBLIC & STAKEHOLDERS' CONSULTATION MEETING MINUTES:

ENVIRONMENTAL SCOPING ASSESSMENT (ESA) FOR THE PROPOSED MINERAL EXPLORATION ACTIVITIES ON EXCLUSIVE PROSPECTING LICENSE (EPL) NO. 8508 LOCATED WEST OF KAMANJAB IN THE KUNENE REGION, NAMIBIA

The Consultation Meeting was attended by forty (40) people as provided in the attendance register **attached hereto**.

INTRODUCTION AND WELCOMING REMARKS

The meeting was officially opened by Ms. Fredrika Shagama (Environmental Consultant) and welcomed everyone to the meeting. Ms. Marcheline Podewiltz from the ≠Khoadi-//Hôas Conservancy provided translations from English to Nama-Damara Language and vice-versa throughout the meeting.

The meeting attendance register was circulated for the attendees to write down their names, contact details to be added to the list of I&APs and receive further information on the EIA process.

MEETING AGENDA AND PRESENTATION

The agenda of the meeting included the following main points:

- Explanation of what an ESA is, its Process and the Public Role in the Process: The purpose of the meeting was given to the attendees with reference to the Environmental Management Act (EMA) No. 7 of 2007 and its 2012 Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations on Public Consultation. Ms. Shagama further explained what an ESA is and that the proposed exploration activities are one of the listed activities in the 2012 EIA Regulations of the EMA that cannot be undertaken without an Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC) from the Environmental Commissioner. Se further clarified that the Proponent (Codebreak Investments) has not been granted the rights to explore in the area yet, pending an ECC. Therefore, the Ministry of Mines and Energy (MME) has only given the Proponent a provisional grant (intention to grant the EPL).
- Brief Description of the Project: Ms. Shagama informed and showed meeting attendees the areas covered by the EPL, i.e., ≠Khoadi-//Hôas Conservancy, which covers communal farms such as Farm Condor No. 617, Farm Emmanuel No. 613, Farm No. 612, Farm Deo Volento No. 610, and Farm Atlanta No. 618. It was found that Farm Bruno 614 and Ombonde 616 are commercial farms (to be consulted). She further presented a summary of the proposed prospecting and exploration methods to give the attendees an idea of what the project will entail. She also indicated that the Proponent applied to be granted for the rights to prospect & explore for Base & Rare Metals, Dimension Stone, Industrial Minerals, and Precious Metals as indicated on the Namibia Mining Cadastre.
- **Presentation of Potential Project Impacts:** The Environmental Consultant (Ms. Shagama) also presented the potential pre-identified potential positive & negative environmental and social impacts associated with the proposed project activities.
- Public Open Discussion (Interactive Session): The meeting attendees were provided an opportunity to raise their concerns/issues and or comments for consideration in the Environmental Assessment Repot and its Environmental Management Plan. The issues and comments recorded are presented in Table 1 below.

	 (a) If the community approves or agree to the EPL activities, then they find minerals near houses, what will happen to the affected houses? (b) If the EPL is granted, will the community / locals get work opportunities? (c) When the need for employees arises, I think apart from notifying the Traditional Authority, perhaps also include the local committees on the farm to mobilize the young people who can work to be consider. 	 (a) The exploration activities hardly require relocation of homes. Relocation can only be considered during the mining phase, if gets to that stage. However, an EPL is not to be confused with a Mining License. An EPL EIA Study only focuses on the prospecting and exploration activities, and it ends there, because one cannot mine on an EPL. Should the exploration activities turn out positive (the results indicate an economic feasibility of a commodity(ies), the Proponent would then notify the Ministry of Mines and Energy and apply for a Mining License. A different and extensive EIA Study to apply for a mining ECC will also be commissioned for that stage with further community consultations as this. Where there are homes that would be potentially affected by mining, this would be discussed in the Mining License consultations (EIA consultation process) and the affected parties (homes) will be consulted in detail to reach amicable solutions. (b) Yes, priorities of works that can be done by the locals will be given to the locals. Codebreak is also confirming this that they would want to empower the local communities to also maintain a social license and work in harmony for the good of the area. (c) Yes. I would also recommend that the communities organize themselves to create community development committee or

4.	Ms. Regina Luntadila (Farm Emmanuel): Can an individual buy share in Codebreak?	Mr. Ignatius Kapia (Codebreak Investments/Proponent Representative): That can be considered, but it would make more sense during mining, if it gets there. However, it would also be viable to do it through a Community Trust to benefit the whole community, and not individually.
5.	Ms. Caroline / Nuas (Farm Emmanuel): As a community, we need to consider the future of our children and their children when we make decisions on things like these.	Ms. FS: (a) You are right, Ms. /Nuas. Hence, the mitigation measures of activities will need to be effectively implemented.
6.	Mr. Otto Hamaseb (Farm Emmanuel): Who found the commodities in the area and when or how did Codebreak know that there is such commodity potential?	Ms. FS: There has not been any groundwork done on the ground yet because the ECC is not yet issued. The EPL areas are chosen based on the geology in that area that can host potential commodities. The Proponent then applies for the exploration rights with the MME in the area to further confirm the potential of the EPL by sampling, trenching and drilling during exploration. However, the exploration rights cannot be granted without the EIA Study done and an ECC issued.
7.	Mr. Paulus Lakale (Farm Condor): The EPL could be a good thing for us if it is done in an environmental and social friendly manner (sustainably), without significant negative impacts.	(a) Ms. FS: Noted, and you are right, Sir. This is the aim of the mitigation and management measures in the EMP. However, this would depend on the commitment to implement by Codebreak.
8.	Ms. Thusnelda Gui-daroas (Farm Neuland): There was some iron mining in the area, and they had water supply challenges, which is also the same challenge with us. Therefore, we hope that when Codebreak starts exploration, they would assist us with this.	Ms. FS: Noted, and Codebreak have also noted this.

9.	Ms. Fredrika Shagama: Given that the EIA Study also includes the mapping and protection of archaeological and herniates resources. Are there any known sites of this nature on the farms that we need to take note of?	 Ms. Elfriede !Hoases: Yes, there are the following sites: -Two burial sites (graveyards, old and new) on this farm (Emmanuel Koekemur Pos 2) -On Farm Condor, there are also two burials sites (graves). -Cultural significant tree (known as the "tree with breasts") -rock engraving on one mountain We would like to also request Codebreak not to explore on the site planned for the community campsite, soccer field and the horse racing area.

FINAL REMARKS AND CONCLUSION OF THE MEETING

<u>Conclusion and Closing Remarks by Environmental Consultant (EDS)</u>: Ms. Shagama thanked the attendees for their crucial input through comments and raising their concerns. She indicated to the attendees that all their comments, concerns and inputs had been noted down for consideration/incorporation into the Environmental Assessment Report and EMP.

Furthermore, Ms Shagama informed the attendees that the Meeting Minutes will be prepared and shared to the email addresses provided. The Environmental Assessment documents will be submitted to the Environmental Commissioner at the Department of Environmental Affairs and Forestry (DEAF) for consideration of the ECC and subsequently consideration of MME to grant Codebreak the rights to prospect and explore on the EPL. The Environmental Assessment Report and EMP will be shared with the Traditional Authority, Conservancy and send to the email addresses provided in the meeting attendance register.

The meeting was adjourned at 14h10.
