The Consultation Meeting was attended by six (4) interested & affected parties (I&APs) and three (3) Consultants from Excel Dynamic Solutions (Pty) Ltd (EDS) and two (2) representatives of the Proponent - **Please refer to the attached attendance register.**

**INTRODUCTION AND WELCOMING REMARKS**

The meeting was officially opened by Ms. Fredrika Shagama (Environmental Consultant), who expressed gratitude to everyone in attendance for making time to attend the meeting. She introduced the consulting team from EDS and welcomed all attendees. The meeting attendance register was circulated for the attendees to write down their names, contact details to be added to the list of I&APs and receive further information on the EIA process. The copies of the Background Information Document (BID) were circulated to the attendees for self-reading and follow the proceedings of the meeting and ask questions.

Ms. Shagama explained that the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Study and application for the Environmental Clearance certificate (ECC) is done on behalf of Africa Big Rhino Mining (Pty) Ltd by Excel Dynamic Solutions (Pty) Ltd (EDS), independent environmental consultants

## MEETING AGENDA AND PRESENTATION

The agenda of the meeting included the following main points:

- **Explanation of what an EIA is, its Process and the Public Role in the Process:** Ms. Shagama explained that the EIA Study is a requirement by the Environmental Management Act (EMA) No. 7 of 2007 and its 2012 Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations that mining related activities need to be environmentally cleared by undertaking an EIA Study and apply for an ECC from the Environmental Commissioner. The Public and Stakeholders Consultation is required as per Section 21 to 24 of the EIA Regulations. She explained that Africa Big Rhino Mining has applied for a Mining License from the Ministry of Mines & Energy (MME), however the granting of the Mining License is subject to an ECC. Thus, the EIA Study.
- **Brief Description of the Project:** Ms. Shagama provided a short description of the planned mining activities (mining of dimension stone (marble)) to provide the attendees with an idea of what will be carried out for the project once it is environmentally cleared.
- **Presentation of Potential Project Impacts:** The pre-identified potential positive & negative environmental and social impacts of the project activities were provided.
- **Public Open Discussion (Interactive Session):** The floor was opened to attendees to ask questions, raise concerns and issues that need to be considered in the EIA Report. The environmental questions were answered by the Environmental Consultant (Ms. Shagama) and technical questions were answered by Africa Big Rhino Mining representatives. The issues and comments recorded are presented in **Table 1**.
