

Public Consultations Process

4.6.1 Overview

Public and stakeholder consultation process was provided for in the environmental assessment process undertaken for the EPL 8724. According to the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations No. 30 of 2012 and the Environmental Management Act, (EMA), 2007, (Act No. 7 of 2007), a person conducting a public consultation process must give notice to all Interested and Affected Parties (I&AP) of the application which is subjected to public consultation.

The EIA Regulations clearly state that potential interested and affected parties must be provided with a reasonable opportunity period to comment on the application under Section 21(6) of the EIA Regulations.

Public consultation process was undertaken during the month of October 2021 and field visit October 2022 with the farmers.
