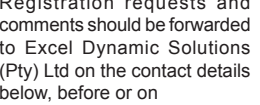

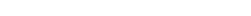

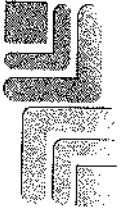
FINAL REMARKS AND CONCLUSION OF THE MEETING

The meeting was adjourned at 15h00.



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


