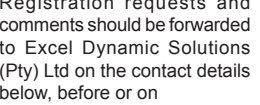

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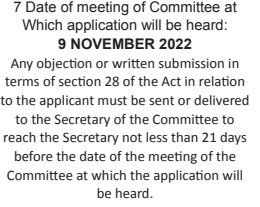

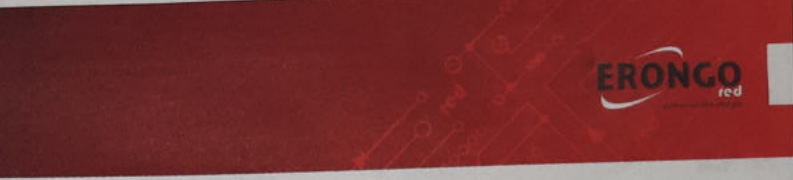

The Consultation Meeting was attended by twenty-four (24) people, including (3) Consultants from Excel Dynamic Solutions (Pty) Ltd (EDS) and two (2) Proponent representatives - **Please refer to the attached signed attendance register.**

INTRODUCTION AND WELCOMING REMARKS

The meeting was officially opened by Ms. Fredrika Shagama (Environmental Consultant) and Senior Traditional Councilor (Cllr). Aletha Geies (who provided translations from English to Damara Language and vice-versa). Ms. Shagama welcomed everyone and expressed gratitude to everyone in attendance

for making time to attend the meeting. She introduced the consulting team from EDS. The meeting attendance register was circulated for the attendees to write down their names and contact details to be added to the list of I&APs and receive further information on the EIA process. The copies of the Background Information Document (BID) were circulated to the attendees for self-reading and asking questions after the presentation by the Environmental Consultant.

MEETING AGENDA AND PRESENTATION

The agenda of the meeting included the following main points:

Explanation of what an EIA is, its Process, and the Public Role in the Process: Ms. Shagama explained that the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Study and application for the Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC) is done by Excel Dynamic Solutions (Pty) Ltd (EDS), independent environmental consultants on behalf of Mr. Siegfried Hengari who is undertaking small-scale mining activities of Precious Stone on the four Mining Claims (MCs) No. 69840 – 69843 covering a combined area of 69.9733 hectares (ha) on the same farm where the meeting is held.

She further explained that the Proponent applied for the rights to mine Industrial Minerals. To continue with the mining of other commodities within the MCs, the Proponent applied to MME for the mining rights amendments to mine Industrial Minerals (lithium). However, this action and approval are subject to an Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC). She indicated that this is done in terms of the Environmental Management Act (EMA) No. 7 of 2007 and its 2012 EIA Regulations that mining-related activities and amendments thereto need to be environmentally cleared by undertaking this Study and applying for an ECC from the Environmental Commissioner. The Public and Stakeholders Consultation (this meeting) is required as per Sections 21 to 24 of the EIA Regulations.

Brief Description of the Project: Ms. Shagama provided a short description of the planned amendments to the current mining activities (mining of lithium) to provide the attendees with an idea of what will be carried out for the project once it is environmentally cleared.

Presentation of Potential Project Impacts: The pre-identified potential positive & negative environmental and social impacts of the project activities were provided. She emphasized that other potential or existing impacts would also be obtained from the attendees living on the farm and or working at the mine on the MCs. These will be recorded for improvements.

Public Open Discussion (Interactive Session): The attendees were given the opportunity to ask questions and raise concerns and issues that need to be considered in the reporting. The environmental questions were answered by Ms. Shagama and technical questions were answered by the Proponent representatives. The issues and comments recorded are presented in **Table 1**.

The leaders together with the Proponent will discuss the employment criteria and related criteria.</p> <p>The requirements will be based on capability and experience, for instance, a driver should be in possession of a valid and appropriate driver's license to drive vehicles and or a permit to operate machines, etc. The Proponent will also add on this now.</p> <p>Mr. Siegfried Karunga (Mr. SK – Proponent representative/Partner): <u>Criteria:</u> Priority of employment will be given to locals. 
