## (GOAT) rivalry set for new chapter

A NEW chapter in the celebrated rivalry between Cristiano Ronaldo and Lionel Messi will unfurl tomorrow when they meet in an exhibition match as the Portugal forward gears up for his first game in idi Arabia since joining Al Nossr

After a glittering career in Europe that saw him win four Champions League titles with Real Madrid and two Scudettos at Juventus, Ronaldo signed for Al Nassr, describing it as the "right

moment" to share his experience in Asia

The Saudi club is the latest stop in Ronaldo's career that began in 2002 at Sporting CP before the forward spent two spells at Manchester United, the last of which ended on a bitter note as he exited following his acrimonious split with the club.

Ronaldo and Messi, who have dominated football's debate about the greatest of all time (GOAT) for the best part of 10 years, will face off on the pitch tomorrow for the first time since December 2020 when Juventus beat Barcelona 3-0.

Ronaldo will lead Riyadh ST XI, a team made up of players from Al Hilal and Al Nassr, against Messi's Paris Nassr, against Messi's Paris St Germain in the exhibition contest where nothing is at stake, but fans are still excited by the prospect of watching the two stars clash.

The highly anticipated showdown, which will take place at the King Fahd Stadium in Riyadh, reportedly had more than two million online ticket requests.

The bidding for a VIP "Beyond Imagination" ticket to the match has already topped 10 million riyals (about N\$44.7 million) in an auction that was set to end yesterday. The game has also captivated fans as it comes just over a month after Messi helped Argentina win the 2022 World Cup, the missing piece in his vast trophy collection.Ronaldo also made headlines during the tournament, becoming the first player to score in five World Cups, but he ended up in tears after Portugal were knocked out in the quarter-

DELAY IN THE PAYMENT OF YOUTH SECURITY SERVICES (YSS) GUARDS

1. BACKGROUND
The National Youth Service (NYS) would like to provide factual information and clarify issues concerning the delayed salary payments of YSS guards, which were due on the 15° of January 2023: resulting in an illegal industrial action which took place on 17 and 18 January 2023:

NYS was established in terms of the NYS Act, 2005 (Act

NYS was established in terms of the NYS Act, 2009 (Act No. 6 of 2005) to provide the youth with opportunities for civic, technical and vocational education and training as well as personal development programmes to enhance their opportunities for employment or self-employment. Furthermore, the Service's mandate is to inculcate patrioitism, sense of nationhood and commitment to Namibia's development among the recruits.

Section 15(1) of the Act contemplates that the recruits who have successfully completed National Service Training be

available, for which they qualify. However, given the absence available, for which truly quality, however, given the absence of these opportunities, and to address the employment needs of the Service recruits. NYS established YSS in 2017, to provide employment opportunities to its recruits as an alternative, while they equally pursue further study opportunities.

To date, YSS employs a total of 1,047 youth and provides security services to 14 institutions across the country.

YSS relies on remittances from its clients for income, and from which guards remuneration is paid. Up to mid-2022,

from which guards remuneration is paid. Up to mic 2022, the monthly pay date for YSS guards was the 10°. However, given the delays in payment of invoices by some clients, the date was changed to the 15° of each month. This was done in consultation and agreement with the guards and their representative trade unions.

On the 12th of January 2023, YSS realised that the cli payments received will not cover the full payroll of the guards, and as such, a notice was issued to the guards and their representative trade unions, informing them of the possible delay in the payment of salaries.

By Monday, 16 January 2023, 60% of the payroil had been collected with a remaining shortfall of 40%. Given this situation, the guards were given an option to either be paid: 60% of their salaries or wait for the full salaries on the 18% of January 2023, on the commitment of the clients. The guards declined and demanded full payment immediately.

On the morning of Tuesday, 17 January 2023, the guards gathered at the NYS Head Office, demanding to be paid their full salaries. Despite their gathering, YSS was already in motion to collect the shortfall, which was secured the same day, however same was only transferred the next day

On Wednesday, 18th January 2023, all salaries were processed and paid. The guards: that bank with the same bank as YSS received their money the same day, while the rest received theirs the following morning.

It should THEREFORE be noted that the guards' salaries were not paid as a result of the guards illegal industrial action, nor did YSS deliberately withhold the guards salaries as alleged and speculated. The salaries were paid on receipt of payment of inveices by the clients, which in any event would have been paid on the 18° of January, albeit the unfortunate delay

3. PETITION During this event, the guards seized the opportunity to present a wholesale petition to NYS management, of which feedback was subsequently provided. In response to the demands, the guards were advised that the issues raised in their petition are matters of negotiation and legal nature, which ordinarily should and will be addressed through appropriate fora.

NYS. on behalf of YSS, regrets the unfortunate delay of salaries occasioned by circumstances beyond our control. In the same vein, while we sympathise with our guards for the delayed salaries, YSS does not condone the illegal conduct of the guards, as it is contrary to the principles and values of the Service and in contravention of the relevant provisions of the country's labour legislation.
Under the circumstances, NYS management and the Board wishes to extend their sincere apologies to paid-up clients and stakeholders, for the inconvenience caused by the illegal industrial action.

Comments and concerns from interested and Affected parties.

I, Theresia S Mouton, owner of Witkop No.458, hereby wish to bring to your attention the reasons for\_my objections in respect of the commencement of the intended exploration activities of Credula Marianna Barros as it pertains to the Exclusive Prospecting License (EPL) No. 8500. Given that Witkop No. 458 falls within the surface area over which EPL No. 8500 was granted, I have a vested interest in any potential externalities that might result from the exploration activities of the said EPL, and thus the right to raise my objection to such activities where I harbour any concerns that it could negatively impact my property. You will find a list of my concerns below, and I request that your office gives the reasons its due consideration. with regards to the commencement of the explorations of which the surface area includes Witkop No.458.

Listed below are my reasons for objecting the commencement of any exploration:

- Water supply Witkop No.458 is known for a lack of water/low rainfall. Since an estimate
  cannot be given of the amount of water this exploration will require it creates deep
  uncertainty as to how it might impact water supply for the consumption of our farm
  employees, livestock, gardens and all other domesticated animals on the farm.
- Soil disturbance and prone to soil erosion.
- Air pollution.
- Livestock theft The increase activity on the farm will create a loophole for livestock theft.
- Potential fire outbreaks as was recently seen, the extensive damage that the fire outbreaks
  have caused, this exploration increases the risk of fire outbreaks and may lead to loss of
  lives, livestock as well as loss of habitat for the livestock and other animals that make use of
  the land.
- Safety hazards for humans and livestock due to hazardous waste disposal.
- Vehicular traffic safety and services infrastructure (local roads).
- Vibrations and noise associated with drilling activities.
- Environmental pollution from poor waste management,
- Archaeological or cultural heritage impact.
- Potential social nuisance and land use conflicts.
- Current road infrastructure of poor quality and may hinder accessibility to our farm.

It is also important to note that Witkop no.458 is being used for subsistence farming and this exploration might not only cause an adverse effect on the livestock but might also have dire effects on the farm owners who use these farms as a means of survival.

It is then my question towards the registered holder(s) of the said EPL 8500 – Credula Marianna Barros, Excel Dynamic Solutions (Pty) Ltd, Ministry of Mines and Energy (Namibian Government) to find out who gives you/them jurisdiction over the Private and Collective property in the Rehoboth Gebiet, which is held in private trust (boedel) and administered in the Office of the legally elected Captain of the Rehoboth Burgher Community (Gemeente) as constituted by the Paternal Laws (Vaderlike Wette) and Baster Law book of 1872, which has been respected internationally since the colonial regimes of the Germans from 1923 and internationally signed treaties.

We are suffering from previous exploration activities and proof to that is a very deep hole 20 meters in length and about 100 or more meters deep, is left open without any rehabilitation of

the environment, no fencing and this has resulted to many animal losses over the years due to loose slippery rocky surface around the whole.

This happens four Generation back but the current ones still bears the effect and consequences.

Secondly we are getting very few rain in this area and water is a very essential need for our daily living and for our animals, if we need to give water for other activities, other than agriculture purposes and for daily living, the underground water tables will dry up and leave us with very little to survive on.
