This permit authorizes the holder (or his successors in title) to further abstract and use water for the purpose as stated above, from the existing borehole identified as WW 206397, on the planning map, attached as Annexure A, subject to the following conditions

1. The validity period shall be from 31 July 2022 to 30 July 2025. Notwithstanding the validity period of the permit for three years, this permit may be withdrawn or reduced at any time, should the groundwater level reach or approach a critical predetermined level.
2. An application for the extension of the validity period shall be in the possession of the Executive Director at least 6 (six) months before the expiry date of the permit. Failure to submit a renewal application in time can lead to the withdrawal or cancellation of the permit.
3. The permit is incident to the property and if the present owner sells the property, the permit shall be handed over to the new owner.
4. Enclosed please find the number plate for the borehole. The number plate shall be prominently place for easy identification of the borehole. (Do not attach to movables such as the pump or engine.)
5. All water abstracted shall pass through a water meter and the permit holder shall bear all costs for the supply, installation and maintenance of this meter. The Executive Director shall be informed beforehand if a water meter is to be installed so that an inspection, if necessary, can be conducted. Installation of the meter shall be to the satisfaction of the Executive Director.
6. The permit holder shall take monthly readings in cubic metres of the above-mentioned water meter and enter it quarterly on the prescribed return form, which shall be submitted to the Policy and Water Law Administration Division on or before the 10th day of the following quarter. Official quarters being regarded as January to March, April to June, July to September and October to December.
7. The permit holder shall collect and record all rainfall data on the prescribed Return Form, available from the Policy and Water Law Administration Division or the Geohydrology Division within the Ministry.
8. Where a borehole is situated in a riverbed no embankments shall be constructed around the borehole in the riverbed which could result in the river damming up or its normal flow being impeded.
9. All installations, reservoirs, pipes, taps troughs and reticulation systems shall be leak proof to prevent any spillage of water. The permit holder shall take the necessary precautions to use the water on his property to the best advantage.
10. The Executive Director or his authorized representative in consultation with the Minister shall have the right to:
 - (a) withdraw, amend or replace any condition of this permit or withdraw this permit in its entirety, after reasonable notice to the permit holder.
 - (b) inspect the source and installations at all reasonable times to determine whether the permit conditions are adhered to.
11. The Executive Director shall not accept liability for damage or loss suffered by the permit holder should the relevant source wane or run dry or the period of validity of the permit not be extended or renewed.

12. Should the permit holder not comply with any of the permit conditions:
- (a) the Executive Director may seal the borehole until the conditions are complied with;
 - (b) the permit holder may be held liable for any costs which the Executive Director may incur as a result thereof, and
 - (c) the permit holder shall be guilty of an offence and shall, on conviction, be liable to the penalties prescribed in Section 170 of the Water Act, 1956 (Act 54 of 1956).
