
- a) Consent should be granted for MCs 70459 & 70460.

- c) The consent holder is to report back to the National Heritage Council every six (6) months on compliance with the conditions of this consent.
- d) This Consent does not exempt the holder from any conditions that may be imposed by owners, hosts or any other relevant authorities in consultation with NHC who have a stake in the project area.
- e) NHC shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities related to this permit.

- f) This Consent is subject to the provisions of the National Heritage Act (Act 27 of 2004). Should any of the conditions contained herein conflict with the Act; the provisions of the Act as per Section 55 (10) shall prevail.
