- The Head man started the meeting with thanking the team for taking the initiative to come out and host proper engagements with him and the community on the plans for the project they plan on doing within the area, besides the poor turn out.
- The proponents then proceeded to give a background on the EPL and highlight the plans for the project.
- The headman was mostly concerned with the benefits for the community members, he stated that a lot of mining activity takes place within the community but rarely leave much of a positive impact in the community thus he raised a lot of questions around that point and stating the changes and impact he would like to see come with the exploration activity and mining if it turns out to be a lucrative project. The proponents responded by stating that the project will bring with its employment opportunities for the community.

- The Headman noted that due to the placement of EPL area the mining activities would not have that much of a negative impact on the community regarding health and safety.
- The Headman then proceeded to suggested appropriate areas for the exploration activity to take place.
- The environmental practitioner then went on to explain certain mitigation measures that will be put in place in order to protect and sustain the environment.
- The environmental practitioner also stated the different exploration activities that might take place.
- The headman and his council members also gave recommendation for employment and infrastructure opportunities
- The meeting was adjourned with the headman advising for the proponents to return to him once the project kicks off for more advice and guidance.
