Prior to the commencement of the proposed activities, an application for environmental clearance will be submitted in terms of the Environmental Management Act, 7 of 2007 and Regulations 19 and 21 of the EIA Regulations (January 2012) to the MEFT - Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA). MET - DEA will review the application and relevant reports for a final decision. An EIA process will be conducted in terms of the above-mentioned Act and Regulations.

6. EIA PROCESS

The EIA process provides information on the proposed project and the environment in which it may be situated; it identifies, in consultation with IAPs, the potential negative and positive environmental aspects and associated impacts of the proposed project; and reports on management measures required to mitigate such impacts to acceptable levels.

A draft Scoping Report (including an assessment of impacts) and an Environmental Management Plan (EMP) for the proposed project will be made available for public comment period. Registered IAPs will be notified via e-mail of the review period and the availability of the draft Scoping (including assessment) Report.

7. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This Chapter provides a brief description of the proposed project.

Introduction

With reference to section 1 above, the Ohangwena Regional Council intends on obtaining an Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC) for the construction of a waste disposal site. The sections below provides a description of the proposed project during the construction and operational phases.

Construction Phase

Laydown Area/Site Preparation

Site preparation includes the demarcation of the footprint of the proposed site and the laydown area to be located ± 15 m from the site. The aim of the establishment of a laydown area is for the storage and partial assembly of the project material, machine, equipment and trucks that will be used during construction.

Waste Management during Construction

Relatively small quantities of waste is anticipated to be generated during the construction phase. Waste shall be transported to the Oshakati waste disposal site.

Refueling and Maintenance of Vehicles and Machinery

Vehicles and machinery used during the construction activities will be refueled and serviced off site.

Accommodation of Construction Workers

The construction workforce/contractors (both local and non-local) will travel to the designated sites each day during the construction phase and will be accommodated in Omungwelume or in nearby villages and towns,. No accommodation or any permanent structures will be constructed on site.

Rehabilitation of Temporary Construction Sites and Laydown Area

The removal of all temporary construction equipment will be undertaken at the end of construction activities. This will be done as per Environmental Management Plan recommendations.

Operational Phase

Maintenance of Waste Disposal Site

The Ohangwena Regional Council, will have the responsibility in managing the site during the operations.

8. POTENTIAL IMPACTS

- Biodiversity: Physical destruction and general disturbance of fauna and flora as a result of the construction activities.
- Noise: Noise from the construction activities could disturb people and animals in the immediate surroundings of the activities.
- Hydrocarbon Spillages: Machinery and equipment used on site, i.e refueling of generators poses an environmental risk due to potential hydrocarbon spills. Hydrocarbon spillages from vehicles and machinery could potentially contaminate the soil and groundwater. Impacts on the surrounding water quality due to contaminated surface water runoff and discharge. Groundwater quality deterioration due to infiltration of contaminated water.
- Waste Management: Waste generated on site has the potential to pollute the environment and cause environmental degradation, if not properly managed.
- Air Quality: Some dust will be generated from the activities which can pose an environmental impact and health impact on the surrounding community.
- Socio-economic: Positive impacts such as Employment Opportunities.
- Heritage and Archaeology: Potential destruction of sites of heritage and archaeological concern during construction
