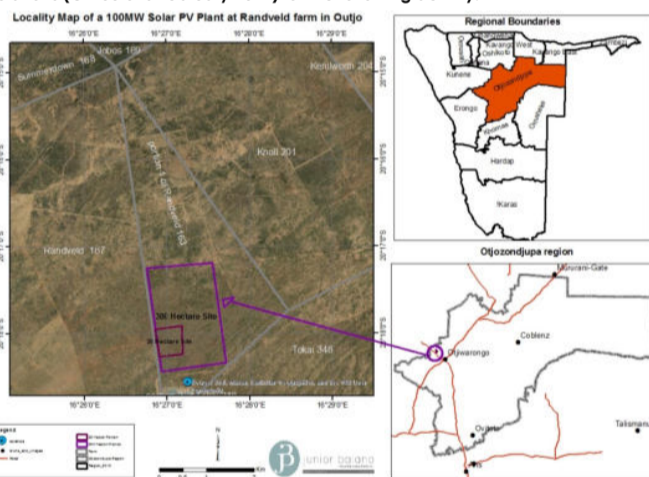

SWK 145 making a change

The 2022 year was a lot more lenient than the previous years that allowed the members of Round Table 145 Swakopmund (SWK 145) to do what they do best by making a change in the lives of community members.

Round Table is an organisation that moulds young men between the ages of 18-40 into gentleman, cultivating the highest ideals in business, professional and civic traditions. They are passionate about serving the community and making sure, they make a difference wherever we go.

SWK 145 started the last year off by introducing their new Chairman Mr Willie Venter and council for 2022. The young vibrant and energetic Chairman was excited. Venter a man with many ideas made it clear that with the support of all the members Round Table 145 Swakopmund might just have one of our best years yet.

SWK 145 kicked off their community projects with fundraising for Vanessa a 16-year-old girl from Swakopmund with a catastrophic electrocution injury that resulted in a burn type injury crippling both of her hands.

Venter and his members at SWK 145 raise funds more than N\$80000, from a Mini Golf Day as well as public donations. The funds were used to complete the 1st surgery and assist this 16-year-old girl and her family with additional medical expenses. Vanessa is doing very well and looking forward to her next surgery.

Continuing with community service, SWK 145 started the N\$5 project. They set up in front of Spar in Swakopmund where they ask each shopper an N\$5 coin to buy any food item. They did two events where they raised an amount in the excess of N\$16000 worth of food items. This food item was donated to vulnerable community members in Swakopmund.

The annual Winter Knights campaign was again a huge success, with the entire Namibian Area raised more than N\$1000000 in cash and goods in kind. Various food packages and blankets were donated to the Welwitschia Old Age home the Swakopmund Rhenisch Church as well as private individuals.

SWK 145 community outreach continues. This time they started creating awareness and raising funds for Pehovelo. When he was 4 months old, burglars threw a burning substance/flammable object through the window of their home. This unfortunately landed on Pehovelo who was asleep on a mattress on the floor. He sustained third degree burns to his face, left sided scapular region, left arm and both hands. He spent four months receiving extensive treatment at the state hospital in Windhoek. This little fighter still has a long way to go and will need assistance once he is old enough to undergo further treatment. SWK 145 managed to raise N\$37000 through a Mini Golf day, a breakfast run with the support of Desert Dawgs @desert mustangs 1313 Mac's Familia Namibia @Harley-Davidson as well as all bikers that joined and donations from the coastal community.

The SWK 145 feel very passionate about caring for the elderly, therefore they started a new project called the 'Wilson Project'. This project aims to assist the residents of the Welwitschia Old Age Home (Phase 2). They plan to help each resident with their dental care, be it new dentures or just a routine procedure. The aim is to have each of them enjoy a 'Wilson' toffee once the project is complete. They managed to raise N\$23000. As you can imagine this is quite a costly venture and we will rely on the public support to get this done.

In support of the Wilson project, SWK 145 also have the Can Project, they placed donation cans at various retailers in Swakopmund to generate more funds.

SWK 145 urges all corporate and private individuals to please contact us and get involved with these projects. SWK 145 is always willing and eager to team up and make these projects a success.

SWK 145 are immensely proud of what we were able to achieve in 2022, they however also realise many hard work still lies ahead.

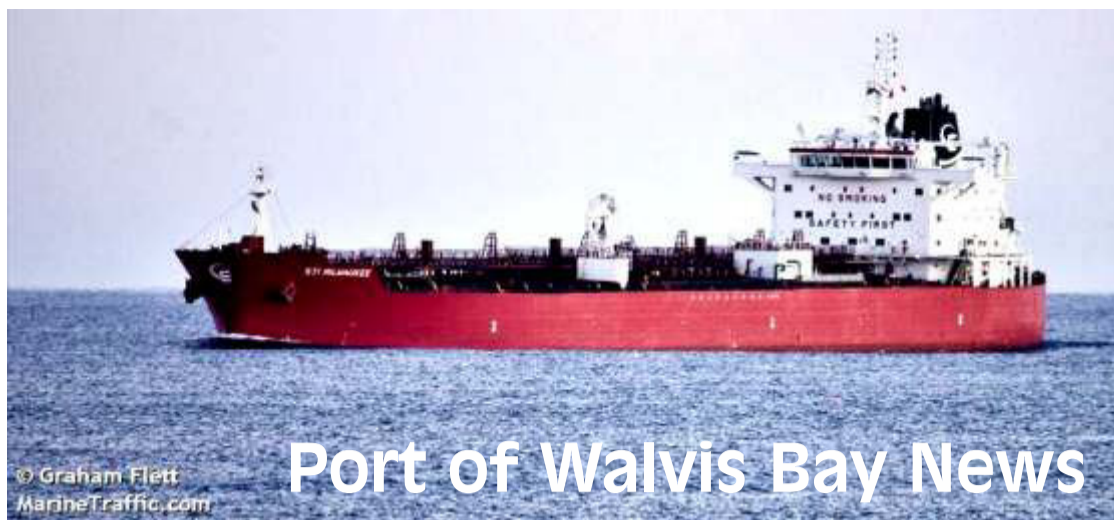

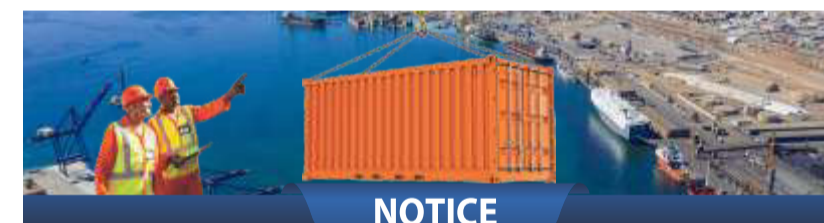
