Major wildlife resources	Elephant, Leopard, Mountain Zebra, Kudu, Oryx, Springbok, Steenbok, Klipspringer, Ostrich
Management	Management Committee of six men and three women. Four Community Game Guards are employed. Monitoring using annual vehicle-based counts and event books
Enterprises	Trophy hunting, own use hunting, pilot <i>Hoodia</i> cultivation project
