**SCHEDULE**

**BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF ORUPEMBE COMMUNITY FOREST:**  
**KUNENE REGION**

The point of beginning represented by coordinates at point 1 is at the intersection of the eastern boundary of the Skeleton Coast Park. From point 1, it moves in a north-westerly direction to point 2 and in a northerly direction to point 3. From point 3 it follows an easterly direction until point 4 and then proceeds in a north-easterly direction to point 5. From here, it moves in a south-easterly direction to point 6 and in a southerly direction to point 7 and from there it follows a south-easterly direction through points 8, 9,10,11,12 and 13. From point 13, it moves in a southerly direction, following the Skeleton Coast Park eastern boundary to the beginning at point 1.

**SCHEDULE**

**DESCRIPTION OF GEOGRAPHICAL BOUNDARIES OF  
 OSHAAMPULA COMMUNITY FOREST: OSHIKOTO REGION**

As shown in the map of the community forest below, the map is marked with points on the corners from A to E. From point A on the north-western corner located on the eastern corner of Mr. Amushanga's farm at Oshaampula village. Point B lies on the south-west of the community forest at the borders of Oshaampula and Omahaia villages. The point is located at the huge *Burkea africana* tree, near Mr. Jason Nepililo's farm, along the former Onkumbula-Okankolo truck (bush) road. Point B to C lies on the southern part of the community forest alongside the electricity power line running from Okatope to Okongo. Points C to D lies on the eastern side towards north-east. Point D is situated in the dense forest at Mr. Paulus Ndapuka's farm. The community members gather at the *Terminalia sericea* (*Omugolo*) tree traditionally used by the Evangelical Lutheran Church missionaries as a church and resting place. Currently the tree is used as a community office for Oshaampula community forest. From point D proceed in a north-westerly direction to point E and from point E proceed in a south-westerly direction up to point A.
