

Big Game: Distribution in Cvamboland,

I have the honour to submit for your information a series of maps showing the distribution of game in Ovamboland and country in its immediate vicinity, such as the Morthern Kaokoveld and portion of the Okavango River as personally observed, unless otherwise stated by me, during my residence in these parts, during which time I have had exceptional epportunities, being interested and continually out on district work, to make field notes. It is therefore hoped that this report will prove of inforest and value to the Administration in determining the present status of big game in the extreme Northern part of South West Africa. A separate map has been compiled for each species showing exactly where each occurs in so far as Ovamboland is concerned, care having been taken not
