I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your Minute No. A. 205/10 of the 4th instant, and enclosures thereto.



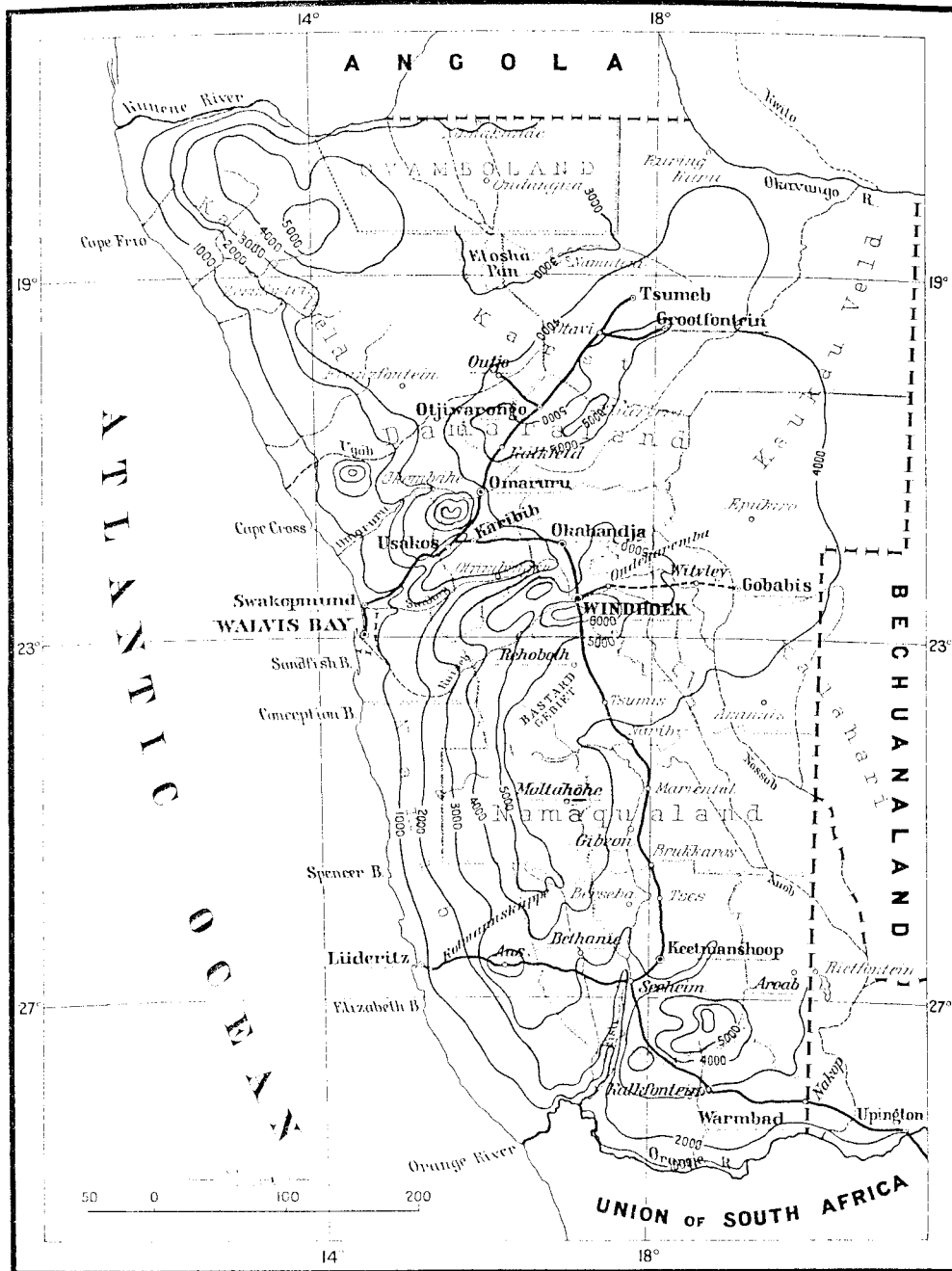
