DISCUSSION

1 Percentage calves aged 10 - 11 months in a sample of 481 animals (18% of the total population) which included bull herds and mixed herds = 22%.

2 Percentage calves aged 10 - 11 months in a sample of 363 animals (14% of the total population) which consisted of mixed herds only = 31,5%.

3 Solitary, territorial bulls comprised 1,2% of the total population (33 out of 2659), cf. 1,7% in July 1976, 3% in May 1976 and 2% in July 1974.

4 96% of the population comprised herds of 10 or more animals, cf. 89% in July 1976, 88% in May 1976 and 52% in July 1974. The largest herd encountered was 370 animals (117 in July 1976).

2.5 The count of May 1976 (fixed-wing) was 2360, in July 1976 (helicopter) it was 2638 and in December 1976 (fixed-wing) it was 2659. This is a variation of 11.2%.
