### EXTENSION OF BOUNDARIES: RUNDU EXTENSION 6

Under section 29(1) of the Townships and Division of Land Ordinance, 1963 (Ordinance No. 11 of 1963), as amended, I extend the boundaries of the Township of Rundu Extension 6 to include Portion 56 of Farm Rundu Townlands No. 1329 situated in the Registration Division "B" and represented by Cadastral Diagram No. A 739/2007 which shall at all times lie open for inspection at the office of the Surveyor-General, Windhoek, during normal office hours.

The properties so included shall be known as Erf 2323, Rundu Extension 6.

#### **SCHEDULE**

#### DESCRIPTION OF GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES: SIKUNGA CONSERVANCY

The point of beginning is at the Zambezi River point 1, GPS coordinates S 17. 51671 E 24. 78645, the boundary then moves in south westerly direction to Kacelwa point 2 S 17.54286 E 24.50635, it continues to Kasane point 3 S 17.54586 E 24.50590, then to Kazulu Katiki point 4 S 17.55431 E 24.50496, from here it turns in a southerly direction to Bukalo bridge point 5 S 17.71895 E 24.51924, then continue to point 6 on the Bukalo bridge S17.71874 E 24.51925. The boundary then turns in north easterly direction to Mudaniko point 7 S 17.69587 E 24.52758, then continues through Choto which is point 8 S 17.68667 E 24.52924 to Kakwali point 9 S 17.67143 E 24.53909, it then follows the Salambala conservancy boundary to Lyangwe point 10 S 17.67311 E 24.57 124. From this point the boundary turns in a easterly direction to Mafulo point 11 S 17.64469 E 24.5 8368, it then continues through Nambao point 12 S 17.55913 E 24.71779 to Kasikili point 13 on the Zambezi river, from this point it turns and follows along the meandering Zambezi river in westerly direction until it reaches point 1 which is the point of beginning.
