



learning during structured activities




Informal learning: learning from the Centre's facilities while doing everyday activities such as cooking, cleaning, bathing and throwing away rubbish








## Challenges

- Funding
  - Programme (salaries) and running costs
  - Transport for groups to NaDEET
- Access to sustainable living technology for participants
  - Solar cookers/ ovens are not widely available

## **Opportunities**



- 67% of new solar cooker owners used their parabolic solar cooker daily
- NaDEET's return rate is over 65%
