

## Angolans believe they are trapped with ivory

Three Angolan men and a Namibian were reportedly trapped in the Akati settlement at Outapi on Saturday with two elephant teeth and ethermagô products.

According to the Namibian Police Weekly Crime Report, the four suspects were arrested at about 11am when they allegedly tried to sell the game products to secret police officers.

"The game products were apparently imported from Angola to Namibia," the report says.

They would appear in Outapi Magistrate's Court today on charges of unlawful possession and trafficking of game products, as well as violation of the Immigration Control Act.

The police investigation continues.

Two men (39 and 33) were arrested on Friday at about 9pm in the Tuhingireni settlement on Rundu with two leopard and three food magazines.

They would appear in the Rundu Magistrate's Court today. The police investigation continues.

In the capital, a 49-year-old man was arrested on Friday with an ethereal stomach in his possession.

"He tried to sell the food magazine at 10:45 am in the Eveline Court parking lot in the Greenwell Matongo settlement in Wanaheda," the report states.

The suspect was scheduled to appear in the Windhoek Magistrate's Court in Katutura today. The police investigation continues.
