

Eleven stuck on 'rhino poaching'

A total of eleven suspects were arrested in connection with rhino poaching or horn smuggling last week.

According to the weekly Namibian crime report of the Namibian Police and the Ministry of the Environment, Forestry and Tourism, a total of 16 suspected game criminals were arrested from 25 to 31 May.

Two suspects were also arrested in possession of two elephant teeth on Rundu.

At Kamanjab, two Namibian men were apparently arrested with two giraffe carcasses without the necessary permits. Seven new cases were brought.

Six rhino horns, two elephant teeth, giraffe carcasses, vehicles and firearms were seized, as well as 17 patterns.
