

Get stuck on rhino poaching at Outjo

Six Namibian men were arrested last week in connection with rhino poaching at Outjo and a vehicle was seized.

Messrs. Jan Haodom, Kamati Tchipito Mutenha, Thomas Eino and Josef Homateni Reinhard were arrested last Wednesday after stripping a rhino in the Outjo district.

Their co-accused, Messrs. Michael Ntsambo Jonas and Alfred Horaseb were arrested last Thursday and Friday respectively.

According to the weekly game crime report from 1 to 7 June from the Namibian police and the Ministry of the Environment, Forestry and Tourism, a total of 17 suspected game criminals have been arrested and four new cases brought.

Two elephant teeth and one each have rhino carcass, ethermagô and crocodile skin and a vehicle.

On Opuwo is Messrs. Rikengenena Kurooro and Karijeja Tjavara on Sunday were arrested with two elephant teeth in their possession.

Mr. Obert Sipilisa Sakutuka was also arrested on Sunday in Katima Mulilo with a food stomach in his possession.

On Rundu, Mr. Romanus Ndumba was allegedly caught with a crocodile skin last Thursday.
