

Pastor Babi is still behind bars

Pastor Jackson Babi, 30, of the House of Joy Ministries and his co-accused, Mr. Friza Dumeni, 25, remains behind bars.

Magistrate Linus Samunzela postponed the two accused's brief appearance in the Windhoek Magistrate's Court this morning in connection with rhino poaching, corner smuggling and the illegal possession of a firearm and ammunition until Wednesday. They will then apply for bail.

This comes after they and six other suspects were arrested last week after two black rhinos were stripped on a farm in the Gobabis district. Two rhino horns, an unlicensed hunting rifle and ammunition, were found in the Babi's home on erf 454 in Kleine Kuppe.
