## Police put suspected poachers

Police have arrested three people in the Erongo region who are said to have recently killed seven oryx in the Namib-Naukluft National Park. The alleged poachers are in custody, said Erongo police spokesman Erastus likuyu. Accordingly, Penrich Gonteb (29), Elvis Anamab (37) and Gerson Mbahuma (49) have to answer for the illegal hunting in a nature reserve. They have already been brought before the magistrate at Walvis Bay Magistrate's Court and the case has been adjourned until July 29 for further investigation. The trio are said to be the people who were recently caught by conservation officials in how they had removed the carcasses. The suspects had fled on foot and left two Bakkies with the slaughtered game (AZ reported). • Photo:
