Repeated cases of poaching

Windhoek (sb) - Six new wildlife crime cases and 13 related arrests have been recorded for the past week. This emerges from a statistical report by the Ministry of Environment and the Namibian Police (NamPol). However, according to the report, two offenses were included that were reported about two weeks ago. "One of the cases is rhino poaching. The incident occurred in Otjondeka and two nasal cones were seized and two suspects were arrested," the report said. The second incident occurred in Walvis Bay, where seven carcasses of Oryx antelopes were confiscated. Last week there was a case of elephant poaching in which two tusks could be secured and an arrest took place.
