Poachers kill two rhinos

Windhoek / Sesfontein (cev) - The authorities are investigating a case of two poached black rhinos that were found in the Otjomumbonde area in the Omatendeka conservation area. This emerges from the police report published on Sunday.

"Members of the local anti-poaching unit had seen the two rhinos alive on August 24, but were found dead four days later," said the police. It is therefore a cow and her calf, also a female. "The perpetrator (s) killed the animals with a gun and then removed the horns with a sharp, unknown object," it says. "Nobody has been arrested so far and the investigation is ongoing." The value of a living rhinoceros is officially valued at one million Namibian dollars.
