An Angolan man and two Namibians were allegedly caught with two elephant tusks in their possession last week.

The Angolans, Mr. Muaka Dinyando, and two Namibian men, Messrs. Bernard Moyo and Kamonga Thitamba, were arrested at Mukwe last Tuesday.
