Prophet Babi returns to court in November

PROPHET Jackson Babi and another man, Ananias Ananias, who stand accused of attempting to bribe a police officer, are expected to make another court appearance next month in connection with the charges.

The two men briefly appeared in the Windhoek Magistrate's Court on bribery charges after it was alleged that they offered a police officer N\$13 000 to make the charges against Babi disappear.

Babi was at the time in prison after he was arrested alongside seven other people for poaching.

The duo has since been remanded in custody and the matter postponed for further investigations.

The state objected to the granting of bail on the grounds of public interest, the seriousness of the offenses, fear of interference and the administration of justice.
