Almost half a million for species protection



The Bank of Namibia (BoN) yesterday made a donation of N \$ 480,000 to the Save the Rhino Trust (SRT). "The rhinoceros is one of the most beautiful prehistoric animals on earth, but it is on the way to extinction due to the irresponsible behavior of humans", said the BoN Deputy Governor, Ebson Uanguta (r). In addition to depicting the rhinoceros on the banknote, the bank has taken a step in direct support of conservation efforts. The funds were raised by auctioning a limited number of N \$ 30 notes on the international collectors' market.
