

Chinese businessman in court over pangolin scales

Francoise Steynberg - A Chinese businessman was released on N \$ 3,000 bail in the Okahao Magistrate's Court on Monday after he was arrested on Sunday in connection with the illegal possession of magpies.

According to the head of the Blue Rhino task force, Comm. Barry de Klerk, is the ietermagôskubbe Sunday at mr. Ma Jingsuo (59)'s business premises in Okahao discovered during a police search.

The accused, who according to de Klerk has been living in Okahao for years, appeared on a charge of illegal possession of and trade in controlled game products.

His case has been adjourned until May 28 for further police investigation.
