Namibia: Angolans arrested for illegal killing of a giraffe


Two Angolan citizens, aged 22 and 39, were arrested, together with a 69-year-old Namibian, in the Namibian region of Omusati for the illegal killing of a giraffe.

The trio, according to The Namibian, was arrested after killing the giraffe in an environmental conservation area near the town of Uutsathima, municipality of Okahao, in the region of Omusati, which borders Angola.

The animal's carcass was seized by the authorities as well as a large game weapon and two smaller weapons, and respective ammunition.

The three men are due to be tried in the next few days.
