## Rhinoceros carcasses confiscated



Windhoek (NMH / cr) - Five suspects were arrested in three separate cases last week in connection with wildlife crimes. Three of the suspects were arrested in connection with rhino poaching or nasal horn trafficking.

On April 6, Hamukoto Kanana was arrested on a rhinoceros carcass in Gobabis. A hunting rifle and 22 rounds of ammunition were also confiscated. He was charged with violating the Nature Conservation Ordinance, illegal hunting of specially protected game, violating the Arms and Ammunition Act and illegal possession of a firearm and ammunition.

In another case, Salomon Erastus Nghidinwa and Lukas Nepwayu were arrested for having two nasal horns. A vehicle was also confiscated. A Namibian and an Angolan in possession of a pangolin tank were also arrested in Outapi. Murangi Kambwale and Veikko Angula and Nghidinwa and Nepwayu were charged with illegal possession and trafficking in controlled wildlife products.
