

Two Angolans fast over giraffe hunt

Namibian police seized several game products last week and arrested eight suspects.

At Okahao, one giraffe carcass, one .303 rifle, two shotguns and 18 cartridges were seized after two Angolan men. John Mantilamena and Victory Andreas, and a Namibian mr. Abed Joseph was arrested last Tuesday.

The two Angolans are also facing charges of obstruction of justice and violation of immigration law.
