One person was killed at the weekend when his ex-girlfriend allegedly stabbed him with a knife and a group of men allegedly assaulted a man they suspect of witchcraft with stones and sticks on Saturday.

The former girlfriend of a 30-year-old man stabbed him to death with a knife in the Omatati bar in Okahandja Park around 6.30pm on Friday.

"The incident happened after a quarrel arose over the woman's current boyfriend. "Her current boyfriend gave the woman a knife to stab the man with," according to the report. The woman and her boyfriend are currently in custody.

Eight Namibian men allegedly assaulted a 61-year-old man in the Otjakati Tjovahimba informal settlement because they suspected him of witchcraft.

The men apparently hit him on the head, back and legs with stones and sticks. All the suspects were arrested.

A woman allegedly attacked a nineteen-year-old Angolan woman with a panga in the Ekolola informal settlement on Sunday night. The women fought over a man, according to the crime report. The victim apparently had a deep wound in her face but survived the attack.

FIFTEEN-YEAR-OLD ENVIRONMENT FIVE-YEAR-OLD

A 15-year-old boy allegedly raped a five-year-old girl in her grandmother's house in the Oshilunga informal settlement in the Omuntele area.

"The girl's grandmother left her at home with a brother or sister. "The suspect entered the house and found the girl in her room, took off her clothes and raped her," according to the report. The boy, who is believed to be one of the neighbors' children, was arrested.

A teenager was also threatened with a knife and then raped in the Damara informal settlement in Katutura this past weekend. The incident allegedly took place in the suspect's home. He is still at large.

YOUNG BOY TAKES OWN LIFE

Three people hanged themselves on Friday and Saturday, the youngest of whom was only 15 years old.

In a tragic incident this past weekend, a 15-year-old boy hung himself with a belt on a tree at the Dagbreek Post 1 near Khorixas. His brother came across his body.

A Namibian soldier at the Grootfontein army base committed suicide on Saturday. Community members apparently saw his body hanging from a tree in the Ondjondjo informal settlement in the Oshana region and notified the police.

Another person allegedly hung himself from a tree at the Katenture informal settlement in the Kavango East region on Friday.

ARMED ROBBERY IN OTJOMUISE

A man was threatened with a gun and knife in Strausburg Street in Otjomuise on Friday night and was robbed of his vehicle, cellphone and cash. According to the report, the value of the items is about N \$ 62 700.

"The items have not yet been located and no one has been arrested yet," according to the report.

On Friday, a 68-year-old man went with his employee to Bank Windhoek in the Okahandja shopping center to deposit about N \$ 30 830. They were getting out of their vehicle when three men apparently ran after them, grabbed the bag with the money and drove away. According to the report, no suspects have been identified yet.

Three men broke into a house in the Okahenge informal settlement in the Ondobe constituency on Friday night and entered the room of a 29-year-old woman. They apparently grabbed her by the neck, threatened her with knives and demanded money.

According to the report, they took money out of the safe, stole 12 Protex soaps and looted two cellphones.

The suspects apparently took off the woman's underwear and tried to rape her. One of the three suspects has been arrested and the other is still at large.

DRUG OWNERSHIP

Police found drugs with a combined value of more than N \$ 25 000 over the weekend and ten people were arrested.

An alleged drug dealer was arrested in the Hoachanas informal settlement on Friday after police seized 262 units of marijuana (345 grams), 1 packet of pure marijuana (200 grams), half a Mandrax tablet and two-quarter Mandrax tablets in his possession. According to the report, the drugs have a value of about N \$ 19 370.

In the same settlement, a 19-year-old man and a 45-year-old woman were arrested for possession of drugs. Police allegedly found one Mandrax tablet, two half-tablets and twelve-quarter tablets in their home.

Five people were arrested in Walvis Bay this past weekend for possession of drugs. Three men, all 22 years old, were found in Kovambo Nujoma Street with marijuana worth N \$ 300 and two other men, aged 18 and 22, were arrested in front of the United Fishing Factory for possession of 61 grams of marijuana worth N \$ 300. \$ 3,050.

One person was also arrested on Friday in Henties Bay opposite the Puma filling station for possession of 77 grams of marijuana worth about N \$ 3 850.

This past weekend, a 21-year-old was arrested on Stampriet for possession of six benches of marijuana. The drugs were allegedly found during a police search at a small roadblock in front of the police station.

IETERMAGOVEL

Two men were caught on Friday in Oshikango in the Ohangwena region during a police search with one dry pangolin worth about N \$ 50 000.

According to the report, the suspects were arrested and would appear in Ohangwena Magistrate's Court today.
