## **ANIMAL SKINS CONFISCATED**

Windhoek (cr) - Last Tuesday, November 8, three men were arrested in connection with wildlife crime. This is according to the latest report from the Department of Protected Resources, the Namibian Police, the Ministry of the Interior and the Ministry of the Environment.

According to the report, two wildlife products were confiscated, including a leopard and a zorilla skin. A zorilla comes from the marten family and is also known in English as a "pole cat" or "African skunk".

Two suspects wearing a leopard skin were arrested near Otjiwarongo on November 8, according to the report. Tjizire Kohongo and Angula Mbwale Kafidi have been charged with possessing skins of specially protected and protected game.

On the same day, a man in possession of a zorilla fur was arrested in Rundu. Ngoma Thomas Mungenye, 55, was also charged with possession of pelts from specially protected and protected game.
