ALMOST 50 RHINOS POACHED IN SIX MONTHS

A total of 47 rhinos have been poached in Namibia this year, of which 32 carcasses were found in Etosha National Park. According to the spokesperson for the Ministry of Environment, Romeo Muyunda, 33 are black rhinos and 14 are white rhinos. "Of the 47 rhinos poached so far this year, in addition to the 32 in Etosha, eight black rhinos were poached on farms that are part of the rhino conservation project. Six of these were on private farms and one in the Kunene region," said Muyunda. Less than a month ago, on May 13, the official number of poached rhinos was 38. Muyunda confirmed that an elephant was also poached in the Kavango East region. Photo: NMH archive
