HAWKS NAB MEN FOR ATTEMPTED SALE OF PANGOLINS

Hawks <u>spokesperson</u> Captain Tlangelani Rikhotso said members of the Serious Organised Crime Investigation unit were following up on information about the suspects who were allegedly seeking a buyer for the protected animal.

The going price for the pangolins was R200 000. The suspects – aged between 29 and 45 – were nabbed at Mahikeng Mall when they were found in possession of the endangered species.

ENDANGERED ANIMALS TAKEN TO HOSPITAL

"They will appear before the Mahikeng Magistrate's Court on 1 June 2023, where they will be facing charges of contravention of the National Environmental Management Biodiversity Act 10 of 2004," said the Hawks spokesperson.

The pangolins were taken to a wildlife veterinary hospital.
