

Acacia erioloba x *A. haematoxylon*

[12 records from 11 (1%) squares]

This is a hybrid between *Acacia erioloba* and *A. haematoxylon*, which looks more like the latter, but is not quite as grey and generally has broader pods. Since it can be confused with *A. haematoxylon*, it has probably been overlooked and is therefore under-recorded and has not been mapped.

It is common to uncommon in scattered localities in the south-east and southern Kalahari, with two records in the southern parts of the central highlands. It always grows in dunes, mostly as a tree of 1–8 m high.
