
Amblygonocarpus andongensis

Scotsman's rattle (E); munye (T)

[5 records from 3 squares]

A medium to large tree with spreading crown. BARK black, fissured. FRUIT a pod, up to 170 x 30 mm; straight or almost so with **four distinct, blunt angles; dark brown, woody, shiny, indehiscent**.



DISTRIBUTION & ABUNDANCE

Uncommon in three squares in extreme eastern Caprivi.

HABITAT

Floodplains and sandy plains.

GROWTH FORM

Tree over 8 m high.

ANNUAL CYCLE

No flower records. FRUIT recorded in December, February and May. LEAVES recorded December to May.

CONSERVATION CONCERNS

None recorded.
